West Medicine Lake Trail Minnesota



The West Medicine Lake is a 2.7-mile paved non-motorized pathway connecting two major regional trails: the Medicine Lake



The West Medicine Lake is a 2.7-mile paved nonmotorized pathway connecting two major regional trails: the <u>Medicine Lake Regional Trail</u> in Minneapolis and the <u>Luce Line Trail</u> in Plymouth. The trail starts where Medicine Lake Regional Trail meets Rockford Road. The trail follows Northwest Boulevard/ County Road 61 along the border of Clifton E Regional Park, then continues on West Medicine Lake Road to the park of the same name. The lower third of the trail is a real treat – it leaves the road and ventures into the park and right up to the beach. Even when the trail merges with the road later, its right on the edge of Medicine Lake. The shared use trail comes to an end just before a railroad, which is paralleled by the Luce Line Trail.


Parking & Trail Access
