The trail begins continues on where the [Downtown Greenway](#) leaves off, heading south starting at the Freeman Mill Road offramp and winding down to Sussman Park. Along the way, users can also connect to the David D. Jones Elementary School, and the Warnersville Recreation Center and Pool beside the school. The lower quarter of the trail brings users closer to Mills Run Creek.

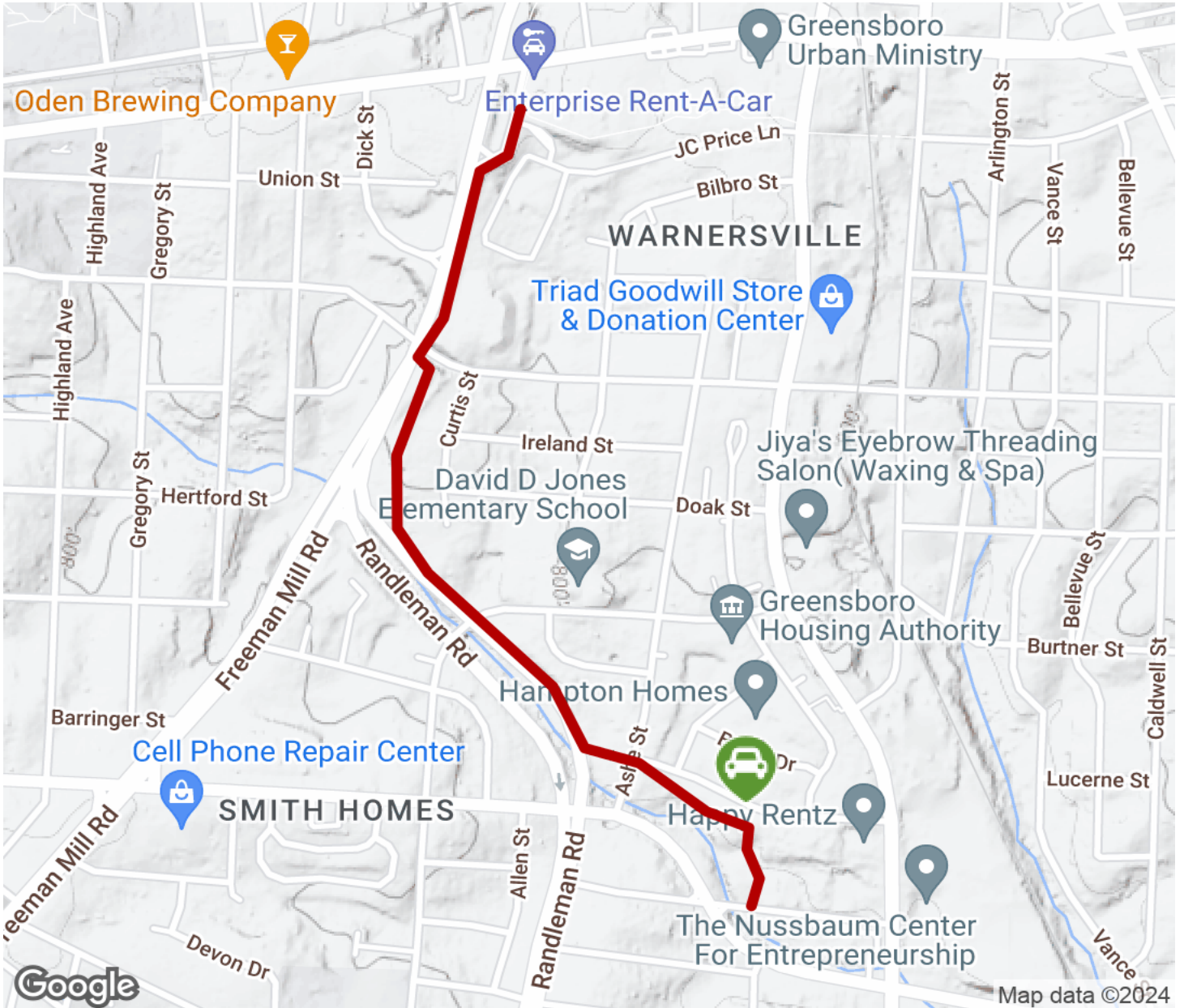
## Parking & Trail Access
