The Levy Spur Trail sits on a converted Union Pacific railbed. It is currently paved between Pike Avenue beneath I-40/ US 65, and 56th Street, although the old railroad corridor continues to the Camp Robinson town line. The trail is suitable for walking, jogging, biking and wheelchair use. It can also act as a commuting path, as it travels between the residential and commercial parts of the neighborhood.

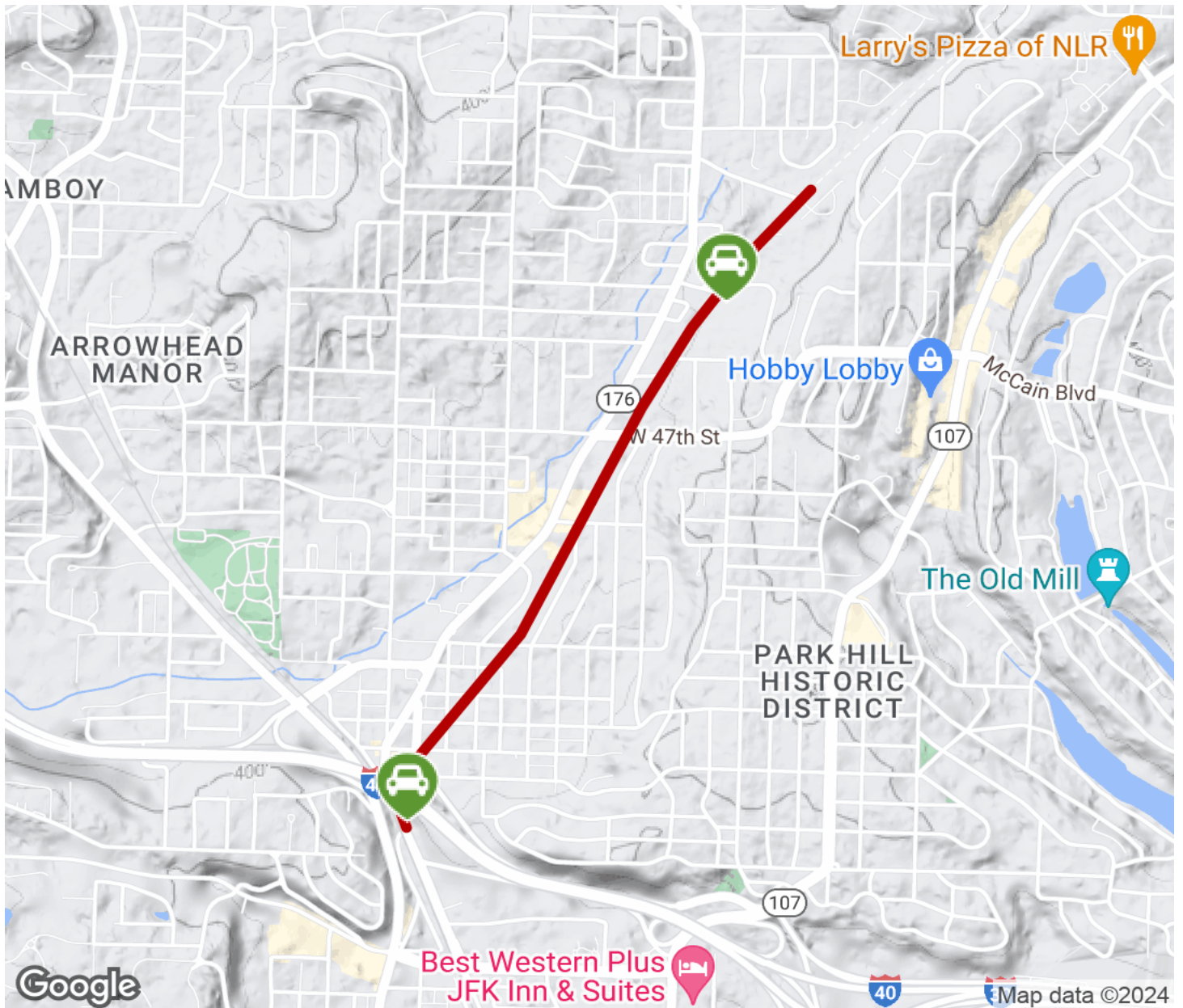
Parking & Trail Access
