The Rock Island Connector runs along a former rail line for about half a mile through the city of Lawton. Heading north from the intersection of W Gore Blvd & N Railroad St, the trail travels parallel to N Railroad St until it ends by Ramada Park (NW 1st St). Along its route, the trail passes by several local businesses, a school, and two other parks —Vernon Park and O H Arnold Park.
