Overview

Not only does the Keegans Bayou Trail provide a safe crossing of Beltway 8 and I-69 for pedestrians and cyclists, but it also provides a scenic strip of nature at the Keegans Bayou Wildlife Bridge for 3.92 miles.

About the Route

The Keegans Bayou Trail runs from South Kirkwood Rd. at West Bellfort (near Cummins Elementary) east/northeast along Keegans Bayou to South Gessner at South Braeswood. Most of the route is paved aside from some brief crushed stone sections. At the western end of the route, the trail runs along the northern bank of the river, before crossing the river just west of S Braeswood Blvd
