The Devil's Hole Trail offers a moderately challenging hike within Devil's Hole State Park. The rail-trail follows the route of a former



The Devil's Hole Trail offers a moderately challenging hike within Devil's Hole State Park. The rail-trail follows the route of a former trolley line built in the Niagara Gorge in 1895. Railroad service ended in 1935 after a rockslide severely damaged the route.

The wooded, unpaved pathway is just over a mile one way and includes a spectacular overlook of the Devil's Hole Rapids. Note that to access the trail, you will climb down a stone staircase into the gorge.

For more adventure, two other short trails are nearby: the [Great Gorge Railway Trail](#) and the [Niagara Scenic Parkway Trail](#). Both are accessible from the Niagara Gorge Discovery Center.

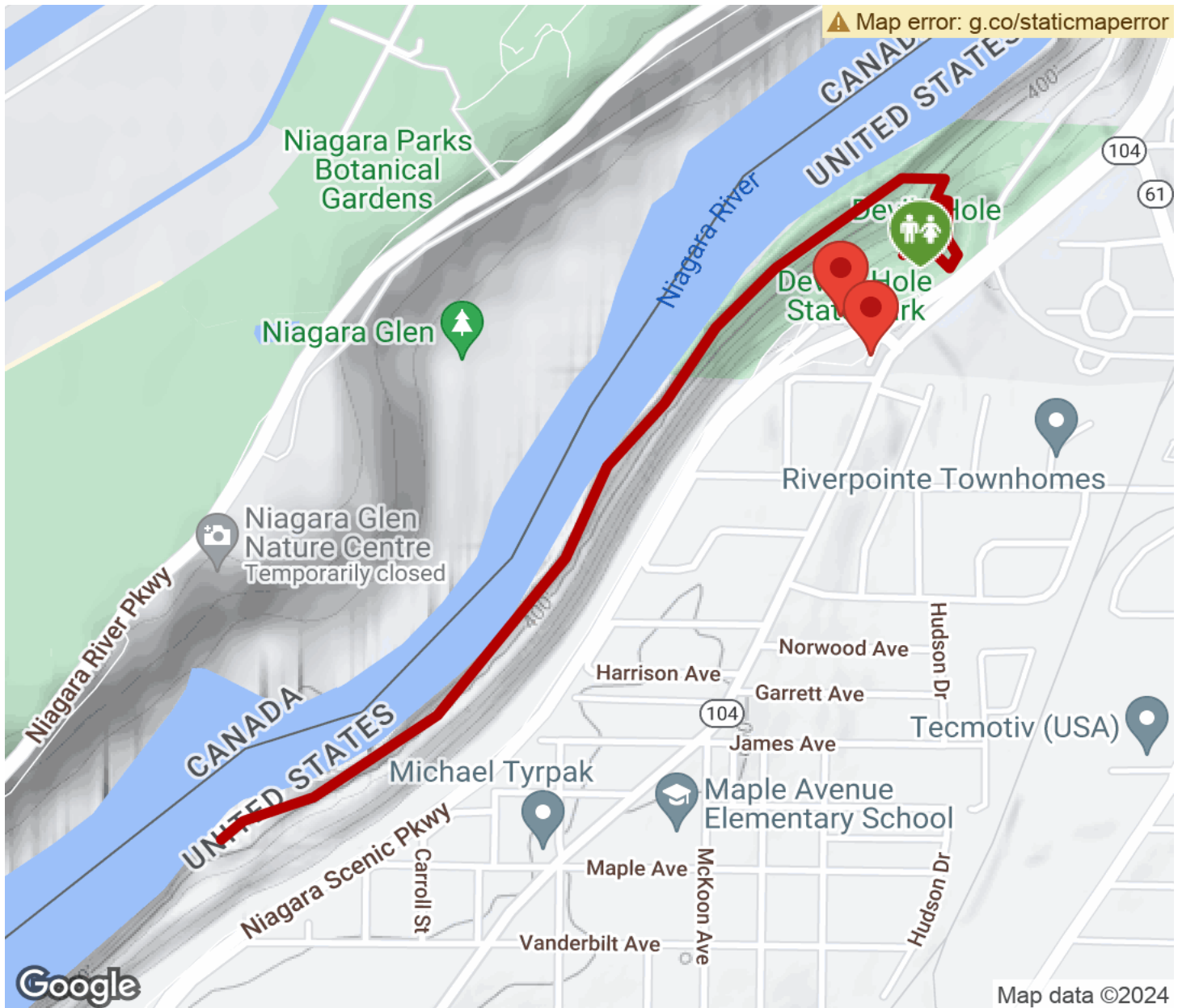
Parking & Trail Access
