Opened in 2017, the Clinton-Fayette Friendship Trail, spanning 7.1 miles, is the longest rail-trail in central Ohio's Clinton County.



Opened in 2017, the Clinton-Fayette Friendship Trail, spanning 7.1 miles, is the longest rail-trail in central Ohio's Clinton County. Following a former railroad corridor, the rail-trail spans the rural village of Sabina, a community which dates back to 1830.

In the middle of the trail, from Sabina Farmers Exchange to the community of Reesville, about 2.5 miles of the route is paved; to either side, the rest of the trail is crushed stone. There is also a short on-road section in Sabina between Orchard Avenue and Howard Street.

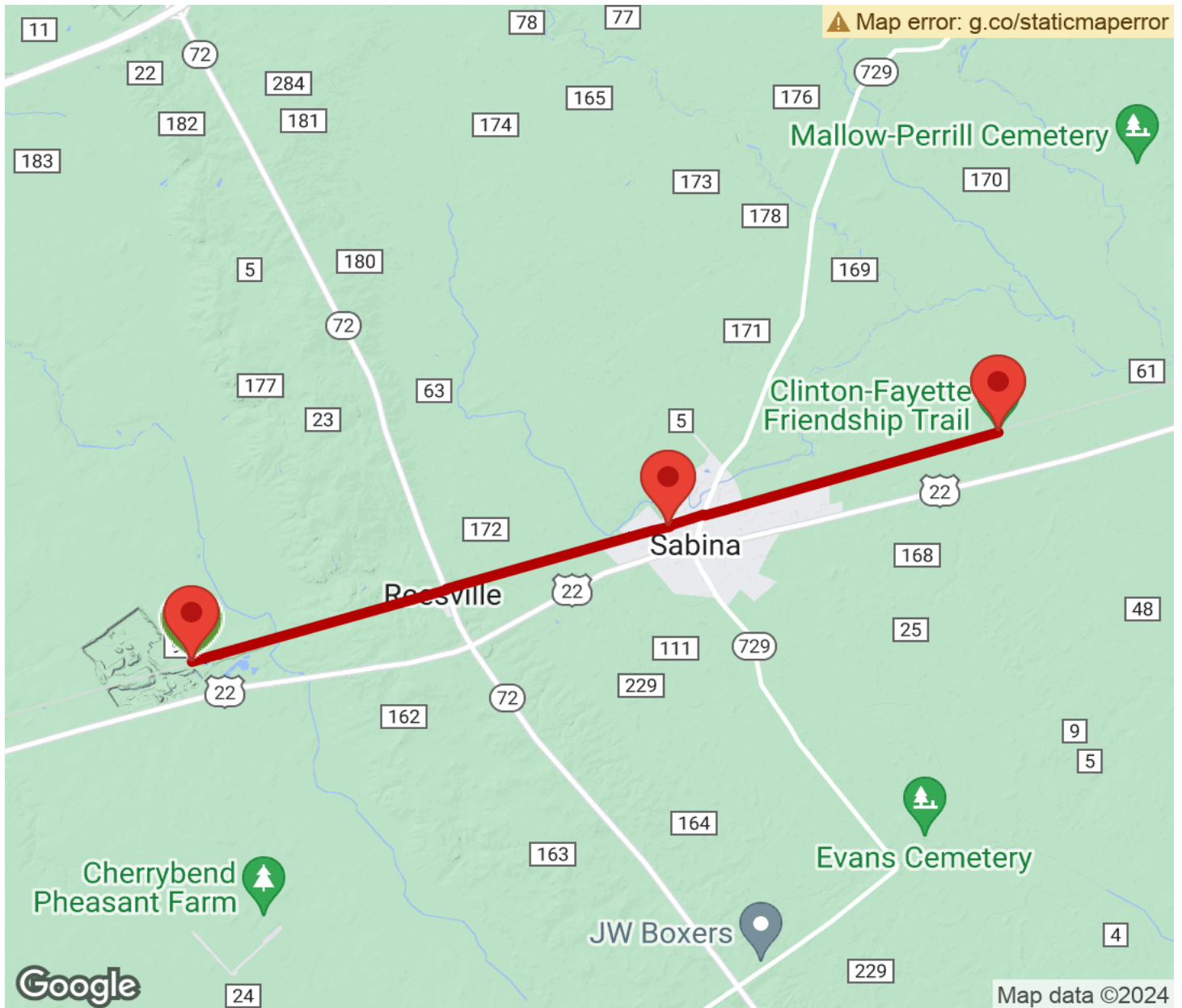
Parking & Trail Access
