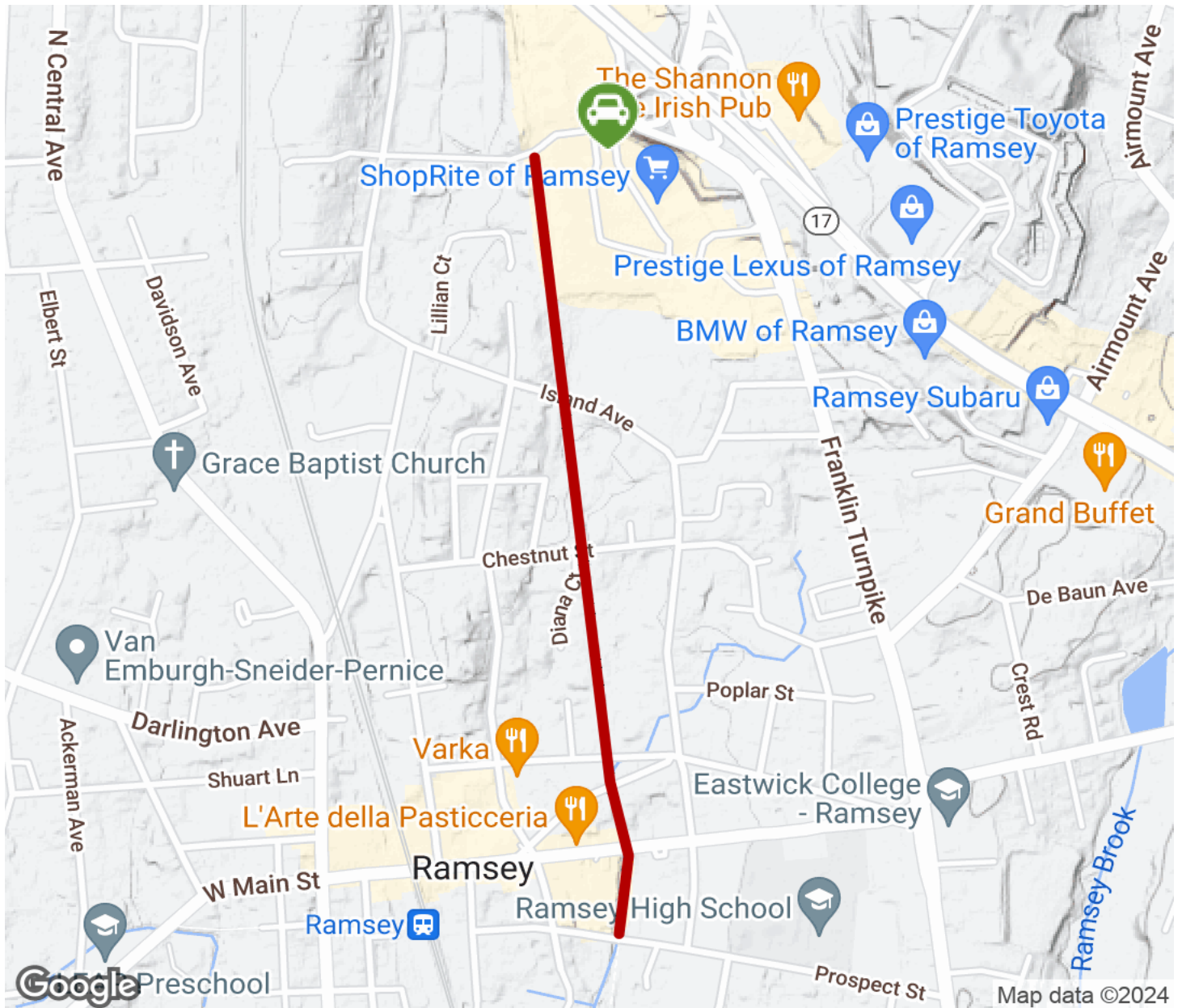
Parking and trail access is available at several locations along the route via local streets.
