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On a map, the 12-mile trail looks like a heap of spaghetti tossed down along the hilly shores of Lake Jordan. There are four different loop trips you can take, or do all 12 miles, depending on how far you want to go through the dense forest. The trail consists mostly of well groomed single-track with fire road and power line sections. The terrain varies from rocky, tight single-track to all-out big ring sections.

Parking & Trail Access

From Rockford: Travel south toward Wetumpka on US 231 (Rt. 21/53). South of Riddle, bear right onto Old US 231. After crossing the bridge, watch for a sign to Jordan Dam; turn right. At the trailhead you will see a sign that reads "Swayback Bridge Trail Established 1998 Trail of Legends."

From Clanton: Take US 31/Rt. 22 to Rt. 143 (appx 12 miles southeast of town); turn left and travel for appx. 6 miles to Rt. 111; turn left. Follow Rt. 111 appx. 10-12 miles to Wetumpka. Turn left at the first traffic light and travel two miles to US 231 then to Old US 231 (bear left). Follow the signs to Jordan Dam. Turn left into the trailhead parking lot; you will see a sign that reads "Swayback Bridge Trail Established 1998 Trail of Legends."

From Montgomery: Travel north on US 231 through Wetumpka. North of Wallsboro, turn left on Old US 231 and follow the signs to Jordan Dam. Turn left into the trailhead parking lot; you will see a sign that reads "Swayback Bridge Trail Established 1998 Trail of Legends."
