The Goshen Avenue Trail follows both W. Goshen Avenue and an active Union Pacific Railroad freight line between Goshen and Visalia, serving as a convenient connection between the two towns. Bordered by industrial uses and residential subdivisions, the surroundings have been enlivened with some tree planting. Recreation Park, home to the Visalia Rawhide of Minor League Baseball, lies at the eastern end of the trail.


Parking & Trail Access
