The Peeler Park Greenway is a short, multi-use trail that runs along the river through the wooded Peeler Park. You may also catch a glimpse of a remote-controlled plane or two being piloted from the R/C Airfield within the park.

Note: Cyclists and pedestrians are not allowed on the unpaved horse trails and horses are not allowed in the paved trails.

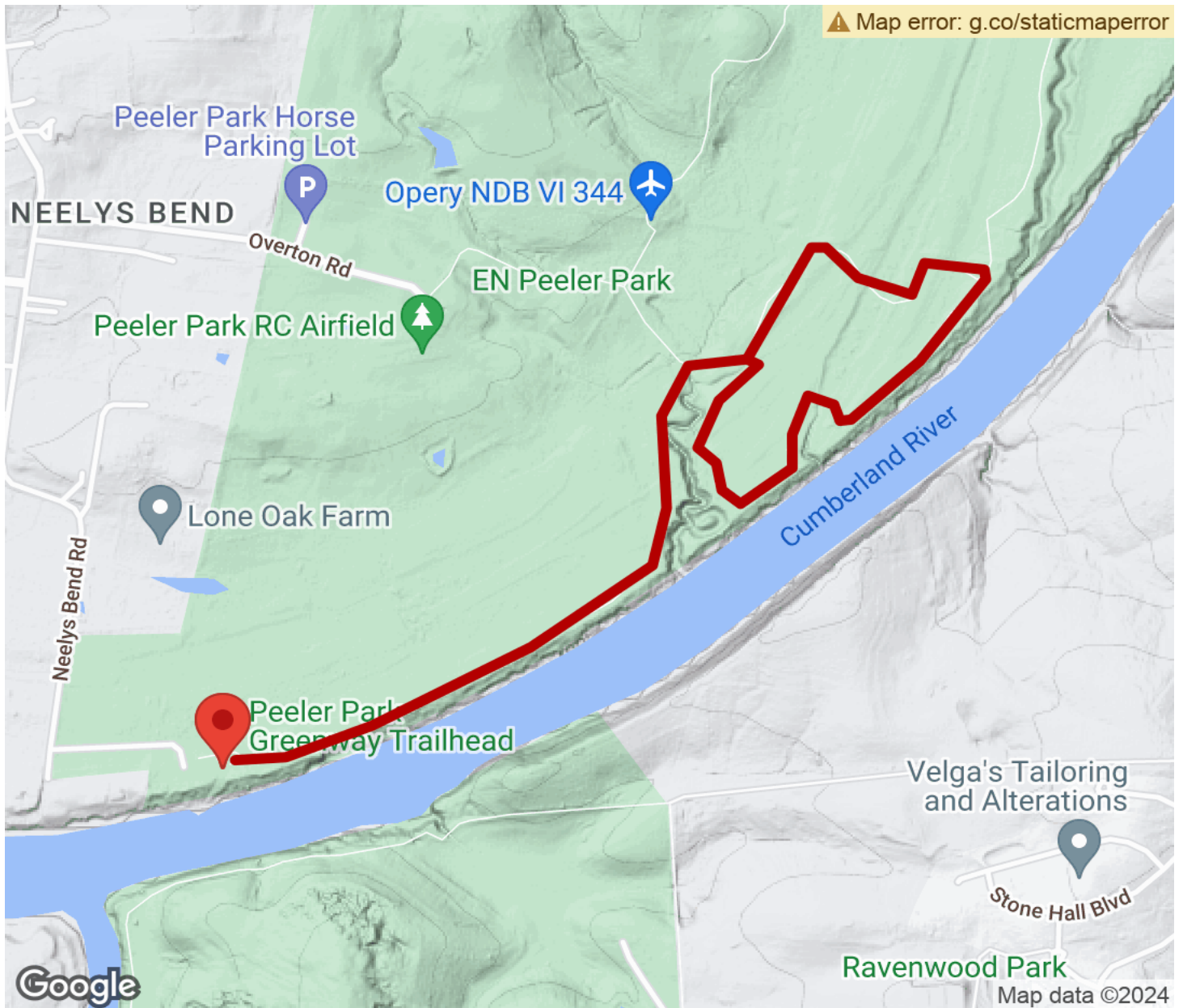
