The Tomahawk Creek Trail follows its namesake waterway through the Kansas City suburbs of Overland Park and Leawood. The trail provides access for the thousands of nearby residents to a number of commercial centers as well as athletic fields, parks and two golf courses. Much of the trail's route is heavily wooded, offering a peaceful respite from daily life in the surrounding nature.

The trail also connects to a number of sidepaths, expanding access to the recreational amenity for even more residents. The [Switzer Road Trail](#), [133rd Street Path](#) and [Nall Avenue Path](#) link directly to the Tomahawk Creek Trail at the corresponding roads. At its northern end, the trail also meets the popular [Indian Creek Bike/Hike Trail](#).
