Railroad Springs Trail Arizona



Railroad Springs Trail runs along the west side of Railroad Springs Boulevard between Historic Route 66 (I-40) and the railroad tracks



Railroad Springs Trail runs along the west side of Railroad Springs Boulevard between Historic Route 66 (I-40) and the railroad tracks just north of Adirondack Boulevard. The trail passes through the Railroad Springs neighborhood and links to the <u>Tunnel Springs Trail</u> just south of the tracks. Both trails are part of the Flagstaff Urban Trails System, a city-wide network of nonmotorized, shared-use pathways.

Parking & Trail Access


Access the trail from the Railroad Springs neighborhood.
