The trail ends near Side Creek Park and Great Plains Park. The latter offers restrooms and picnic tables, as well as a sprayground, playground and sports fields.

Parking & Trail Access


Parking is available at either end of the trail: Horseshoe Park to the west and Great Plains Park to the east.
