The Legacy Trail runs north-south through Lexington among green spaces, neighborhoods and parks. Two highlights of the popular pathway are the Lexington YMCA and Kentucky Horse Park, which features a 1,200-acre working farm, museums and horse shows.

At the trail's southern end, travelers can connect to the [Hope Center Trail](#), which in turn connects to the [Coolavin Rail Trail](#), to reach Coolavin Park and the Transylvania University Athletics Complex.

Future plans call for extending the trail farther south to the Isaac Murphy Memorial Art Garden, named after an African-American jockey and multiple Kentucky Derby champion.

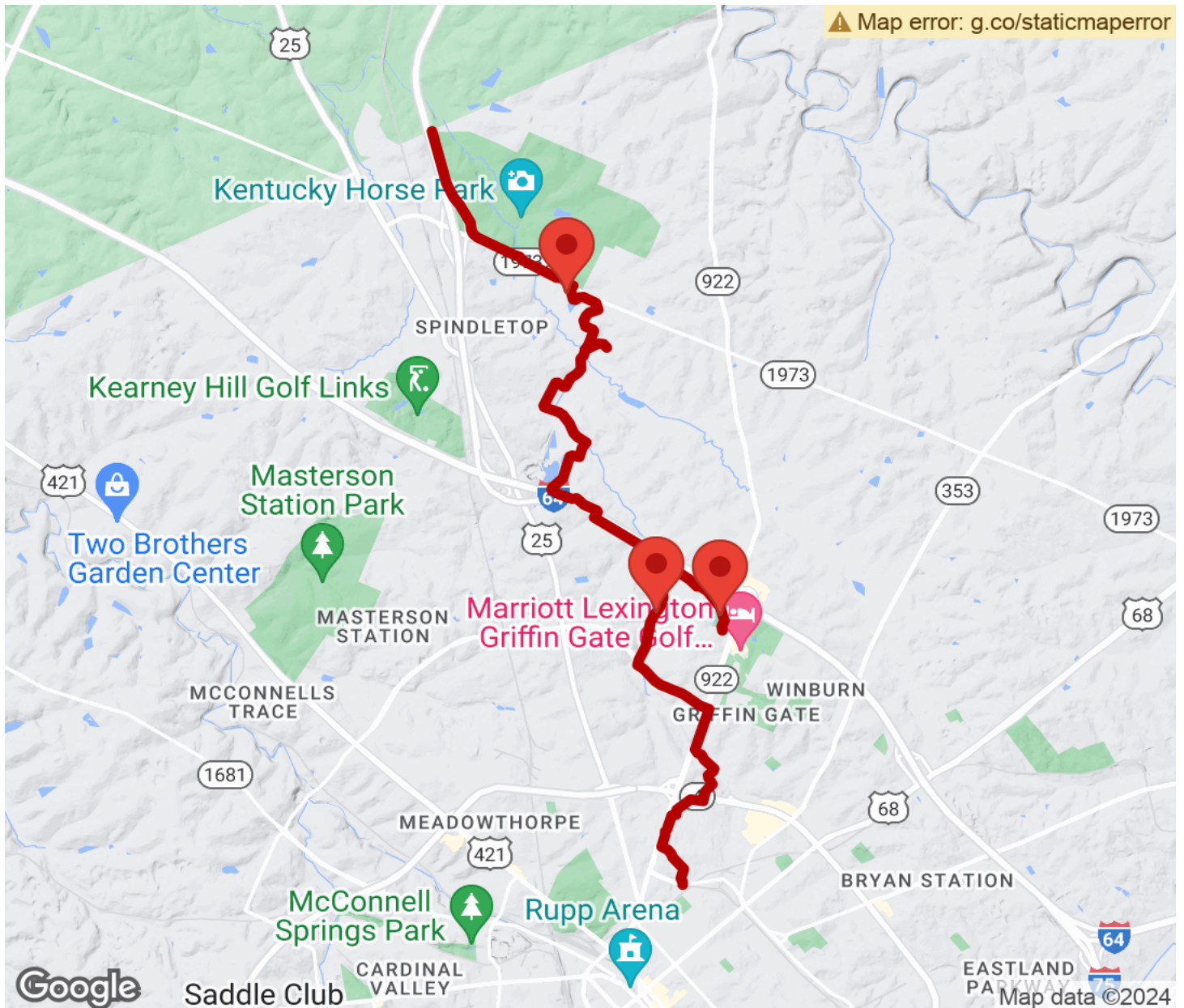
Parking & Trail Access
