The 7th Street Trail is an on-road, extra-wide shoulder specifically designed for pedestrians and cyclists. The path runs for 1.36 miles



The 7th Street Trail is an on-road, extra-wide shoulder specifically designed for pedestrians and cyclists. The path runs for 1.36 miles between Clements Road and Hiberta Avenue, running east-west on the south side of 7th Avenue. It links to a network of other on- and off-road trails on Missoula's west side, all of which provide a safe route for crossing town.

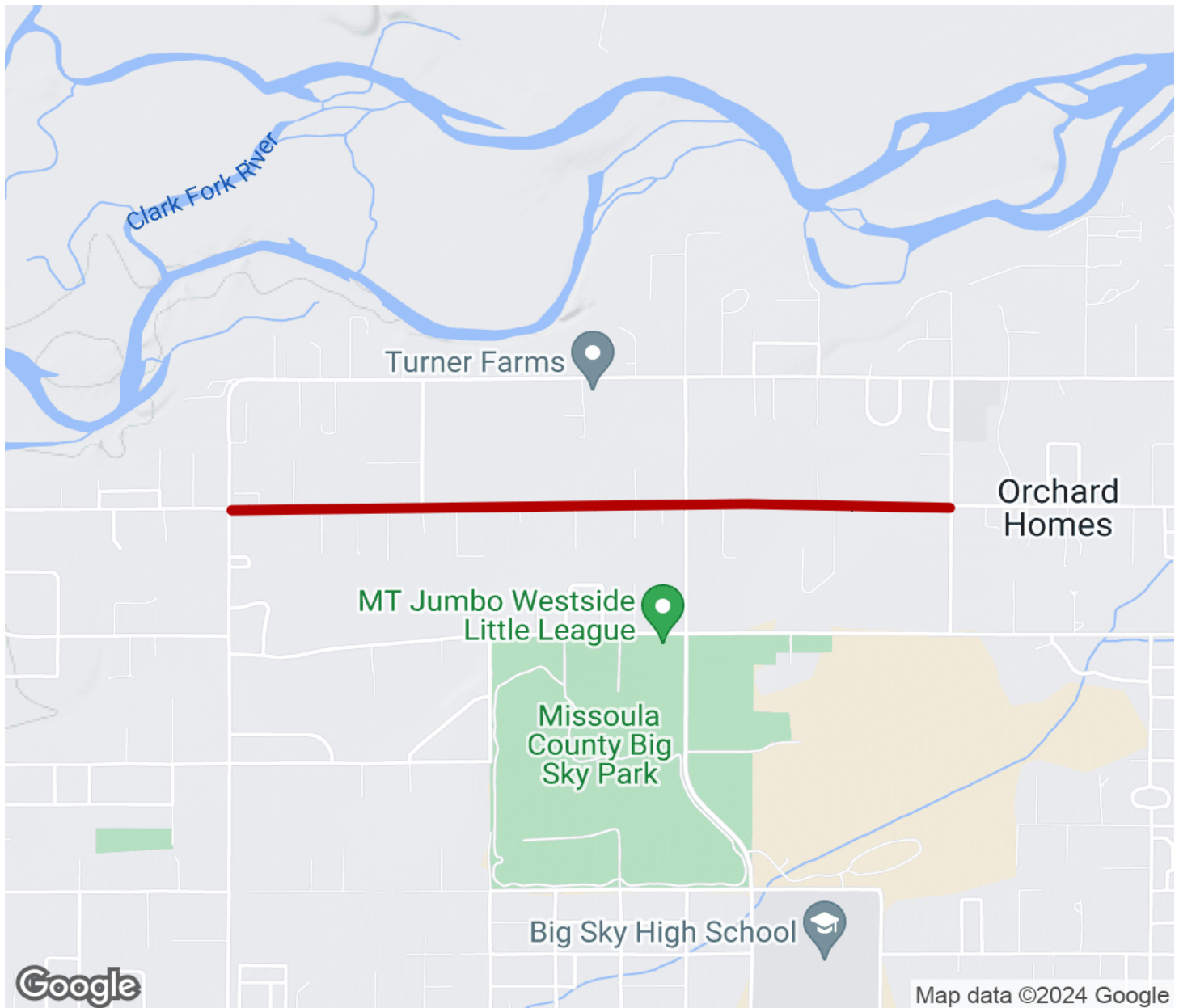
Parking & Trail Access
