White House Greenway is located in the city of the same name, which lies 25 miles north of Nashville, and touches two counties:



portable restroom is available at White House High School on Tyree Springs Road.

White House Greenway is located in the city of the same name, which lies 25 miles north of Nashville, and touches two counties: Sumner and Robertson. The paved pathway begins in the central part of the city, curves around its eastern side, and ends north of White House. Future plans are to complete the loop around the city.

The greenway begins on the south side of TN 76, across the street from the White House Municipal Park. At the park, you'll find athletic facilities, a playground, and picnic shelters. The tree-lined trail continues alongside a creek for much of its nearly 4-mile journey. Note that there are a couple of strenuous hills. Along the way, a

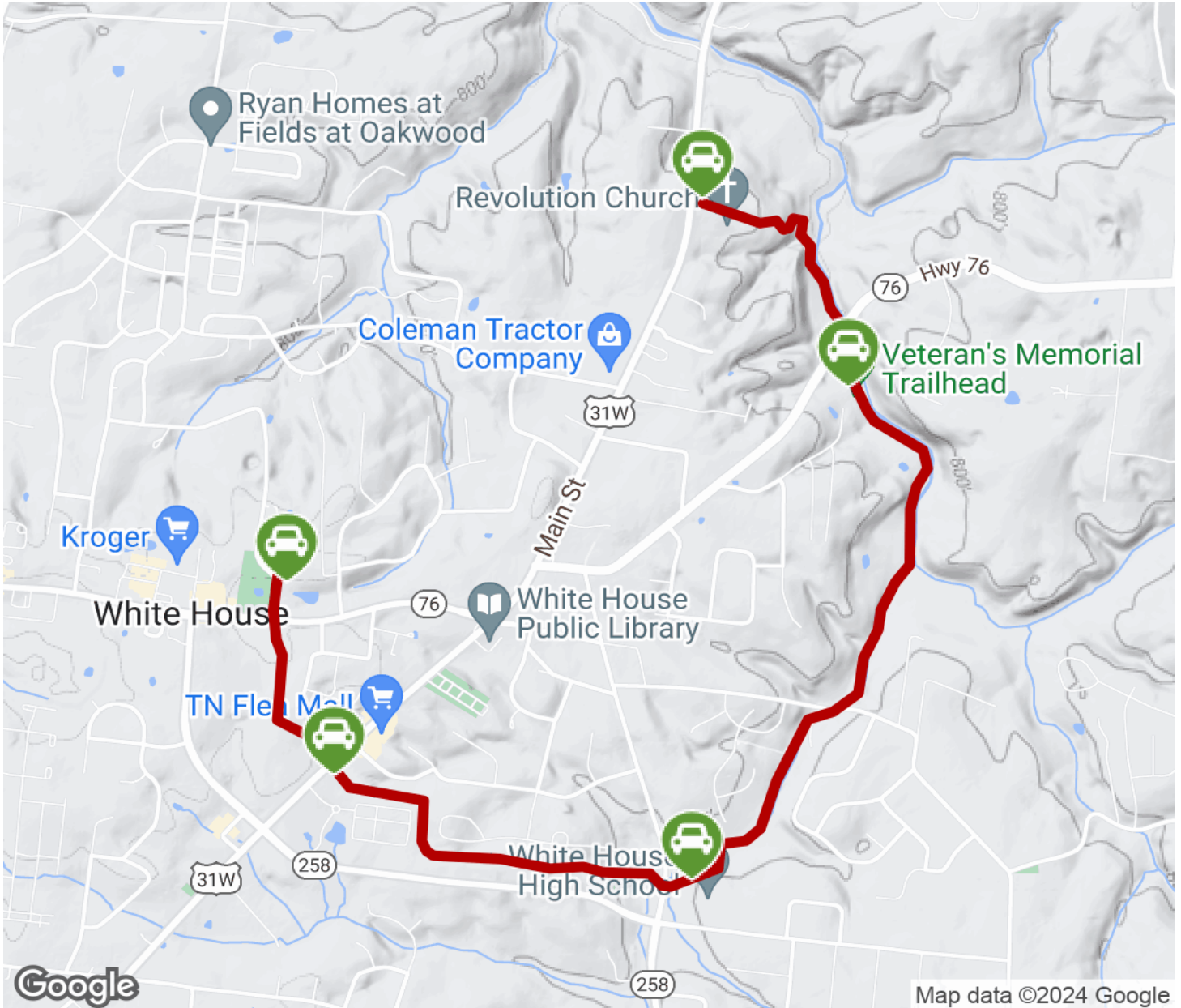
Parking & Trail Access
