Furneaux Creek Blue Trail

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The Furneaux Creek Blue Trail is a picturesque 6.5-mile route that follows its namesake creek through Carrollton, a northern suburb of Dallas. The paved pathway offers views of ponds, lakes, and fields of wildflowers with several access points to neighborhoods along the way.

Midway along the route, the Furneaux Creek Blue Trail connects to the [Furneaux Creek Orange Trail](#) on the water's southern bank by Woodbury. Combine both trails to extend your journey.

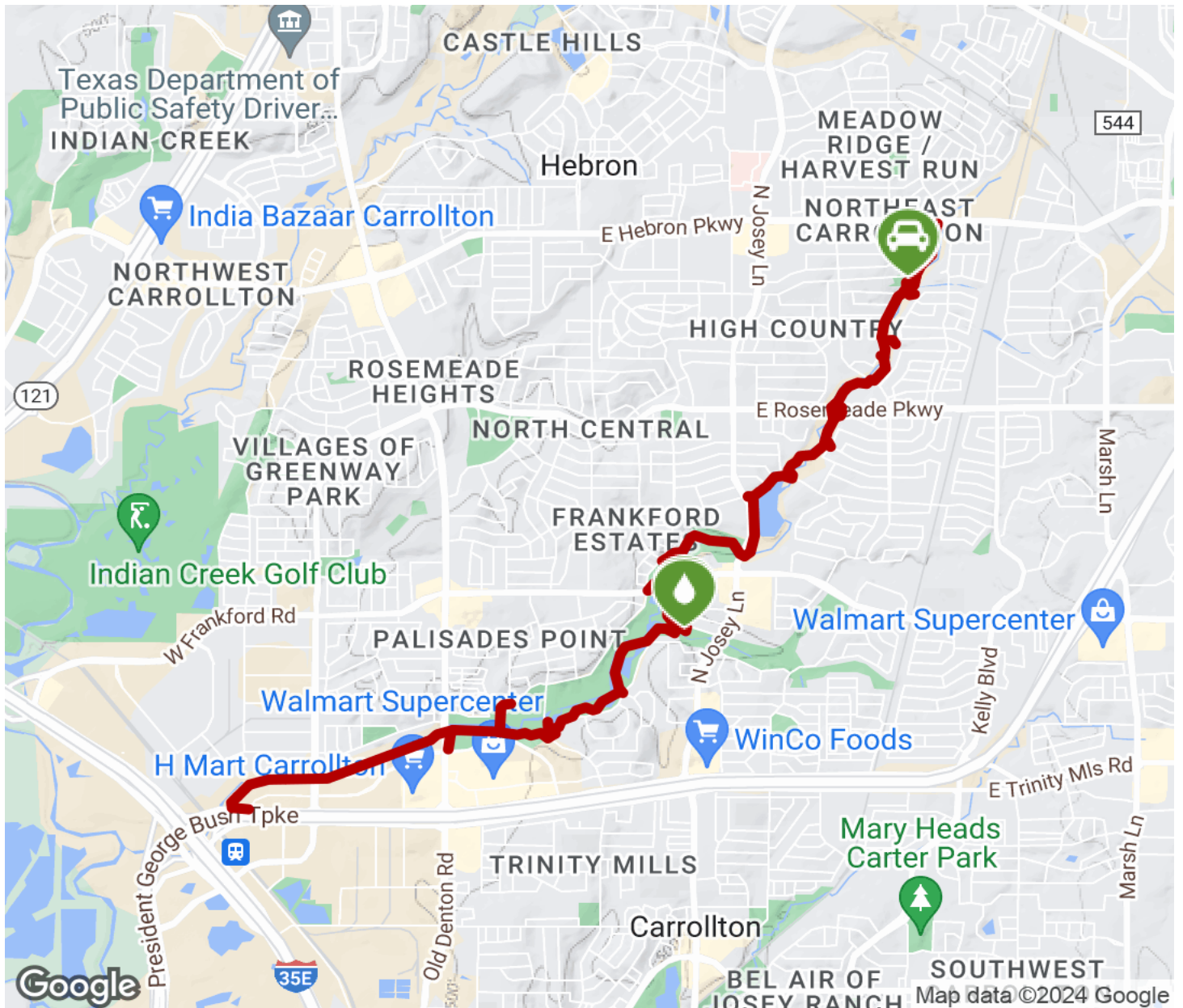
Parking & Trail Access
