The Fort Morgan Road Trail travels more than 5 miles west through the coastal community of Gulf Shores in southwestern Alabama.

## About the Route

The paved trail parallels the north side of its namesake roadway (also known as Highway 180) through quiet, tree-lined neighborhoods and ends at the Peninsula Golf Club. The eastern end of the trail has a few gentle climbs, but the rest of the trail is flat.

The Fort Morgan Road Trail runs between Peninsula Blvd (Gulf Shores)

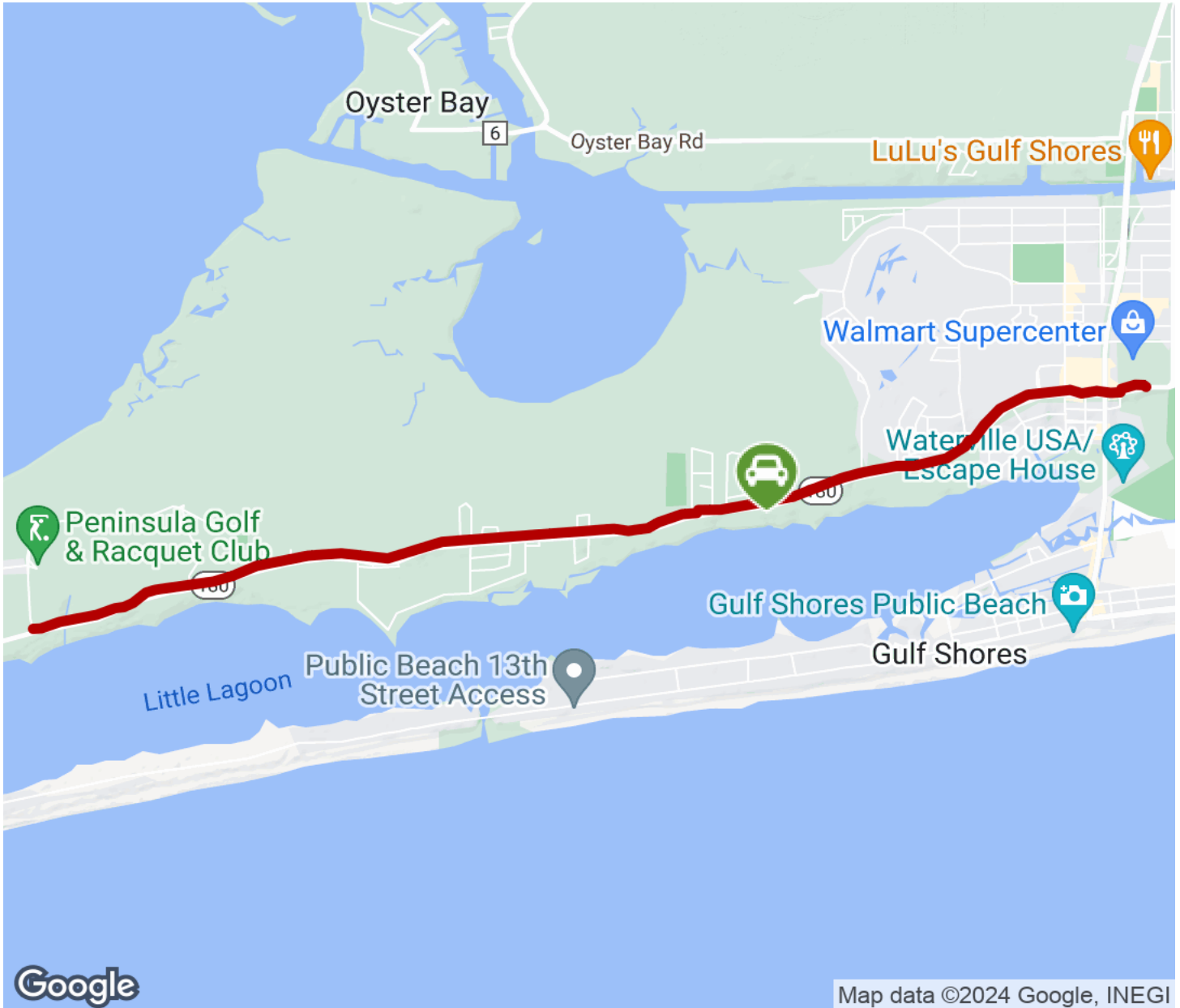
Parking is available mid-trail near the eastern end of the trail at Lagoon Park/Mo's Landing (18068 Fort Morgan Road), which offers parking, restrooms, and drinking fountains. The park is located on the south side of Fort Morgan Road (Highway 180).
