




Fort Morgan Road Trail Alabama

Overview

The Fort Morgan Road Trail travels more than 5 miles west through the coastal community of Gulf Shores in southwestern Alabama.

About the Route

The paved trail parallels the north side of its namesake roadway (also known as Highway 180) through quiet, treelined neighborhoods and ends at the Peninsula Golf Club. The eastern end of the trail has a few gentle climbs, but the rest of the trail is flat.

Parking & Trail Access

The Fort Morgan Road Trail runs between Peninsula Blvd (Gulf Shores)

Parking is available mid-trail near the eastern end of the trail at Lagoon Park/Mo's Landing (18068 Fort Morgan Road), which offers parking, restrooms, and drinking fountains. The park is located on the south side of Fort Morgan Road (Highway 180).
