Goose Pond Trail Florida



The Goose Pond Trail runs through Tom Brown Park, the largest park in Tallahassee. Within the sprawling grounds, you can find a



bridge over the road to access the Lincoln Trojan Sports Complex behind Lincoln High School. Additional mileage of the trail runs from Hermatige Blvd to Potts Rd. and from Potts Rd. to Mahan Dr. near the hospital.

The Goose Pond Trail runs through Tom Brown Park, the largest park in Tallahassee. Within the sprawling grounds, you can find a dog park, disc golf course, playgrounds, baseball and softball diamonds, soccer fields, basketball, tennis and beach volleyball courts, and mountain bike trails. Lake Leon (near the park's southern end) is a pleasant place to take a stroll or have a picnic.

The trail skirts the eastern and northern edges of the park, winding primarily through dense woodlands. Near Weems Road, the trail runs next to an active CSX rail corridor for a short distance. At the Goose Pond Trail's midpoint, the <u>Lafayette Heritage Trail</u> branches off to the east and provides access to Piney Z Lake.

At Conner Boulevard, take the bicycle and pedestrian
