The Mori Ridge Trail is one trail of many in beautiful Sweeney Ridge, a prime bicycling and hiking area in San Mateo County. The natural surface path runs from a junction with both the [Sweeney Ridge Trail](#) and Notch Trail (hiking only) in the east to Cabrillo Highway (State Route 1) in the west.

While incredibly scenic, fog and wind can be an issue on this exposed ridge, especially as you get closer to the coastline. Check the weather before heading over and make sure to always bring an extra layer, even on seemingly gorgeous days.

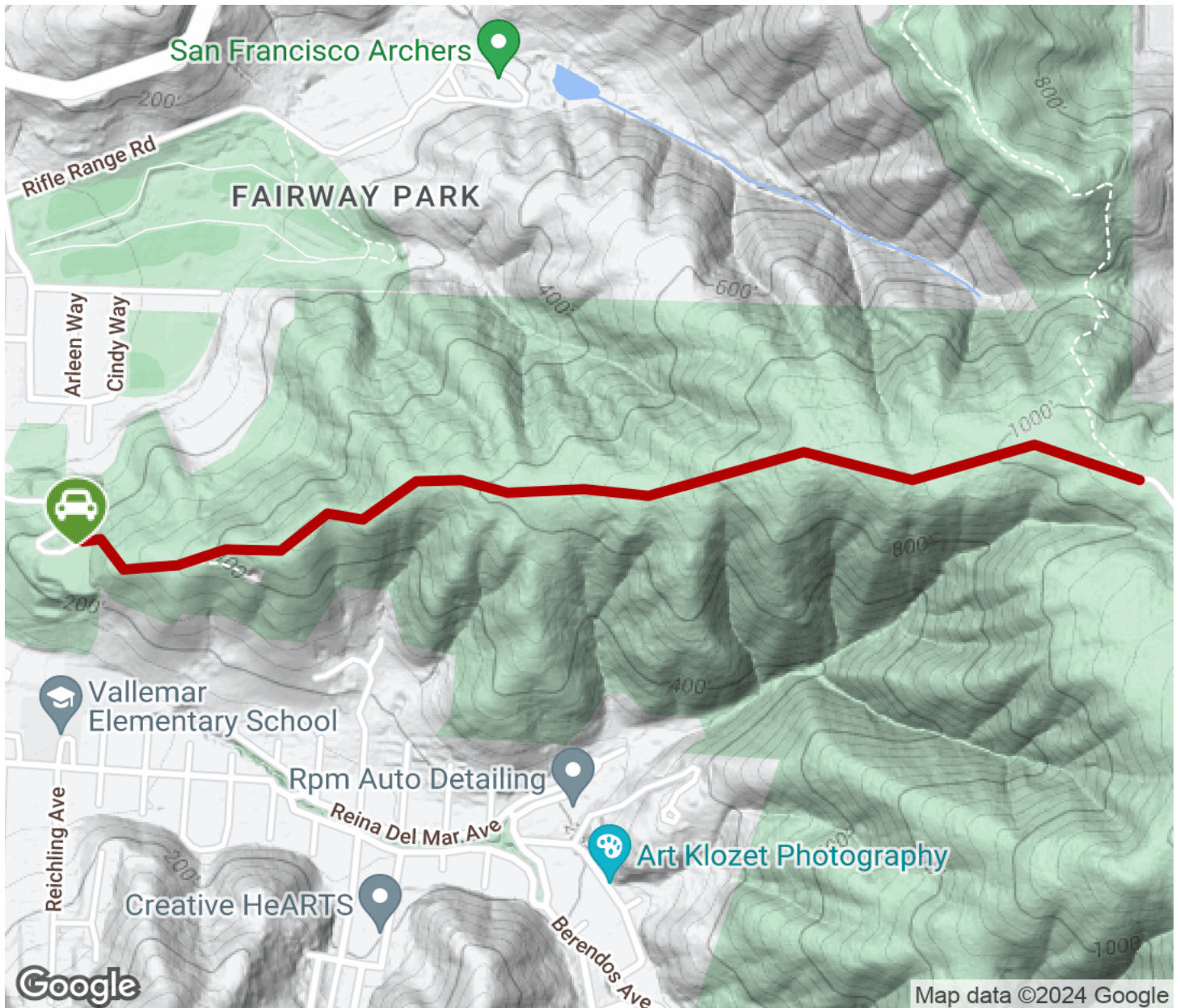
Parking & Trail Access
