The James Ranch Connecting Spur provides an important link between two major trails spiraling out of the trail hub of Xenia. On



The James Ranch Connecting Spur provides an important link between two major trails spiraling out of the trail hub of Xenia. On its east end, the trail connects to the [Little Miami Scenic Trail](#), which spans more than 70 miles. (Note that on this end of the spur, the route becomes sidewalk, whereas the rest of the trail has an asphalt surface.)

On its west end, the spur connects to the 15-mile [Creekside Trail](#), which heads to Dayton.

In between, the paved pathway winds through Greene County's fairgrounds. At the Fairgrounds Recreation Center, you'll find a playground, picnic tables, tennis courts, soccer fields, basketball courts, and horseshoe pits.
