Big Creek Reservation All Purpose Trail provides a paved pathway connecting the Mill Stream Run Reservation, Big Creek



City of Parma Heights. Trail's end is Brookpark Road, along which you'll find numerous shops and restaurants.

Big Creek Reservation All Purpose Trail provides a paved pathway connecting the Mill Stream Run Reservation, Big Creek Reservation, and the Fern Hill Picnic Area. At its southern end, you can connect to the [Mill Stream Run Reservation All Purpose Trail](#) to add another 9 miles to your ride.

While the trail parallels Big Creek Parkway for much of its route, the linear corridor is filled with trees, forming a natural buffer from the roadway. The trail also borders quiet residential neighborhoods and, once you reach Big Creek Reservation, you'll be following the shoreline of Lake Isaac and will have glimpses of the water.

As you approach the northern end of the trail, the experience will feel more urban as you pass through the

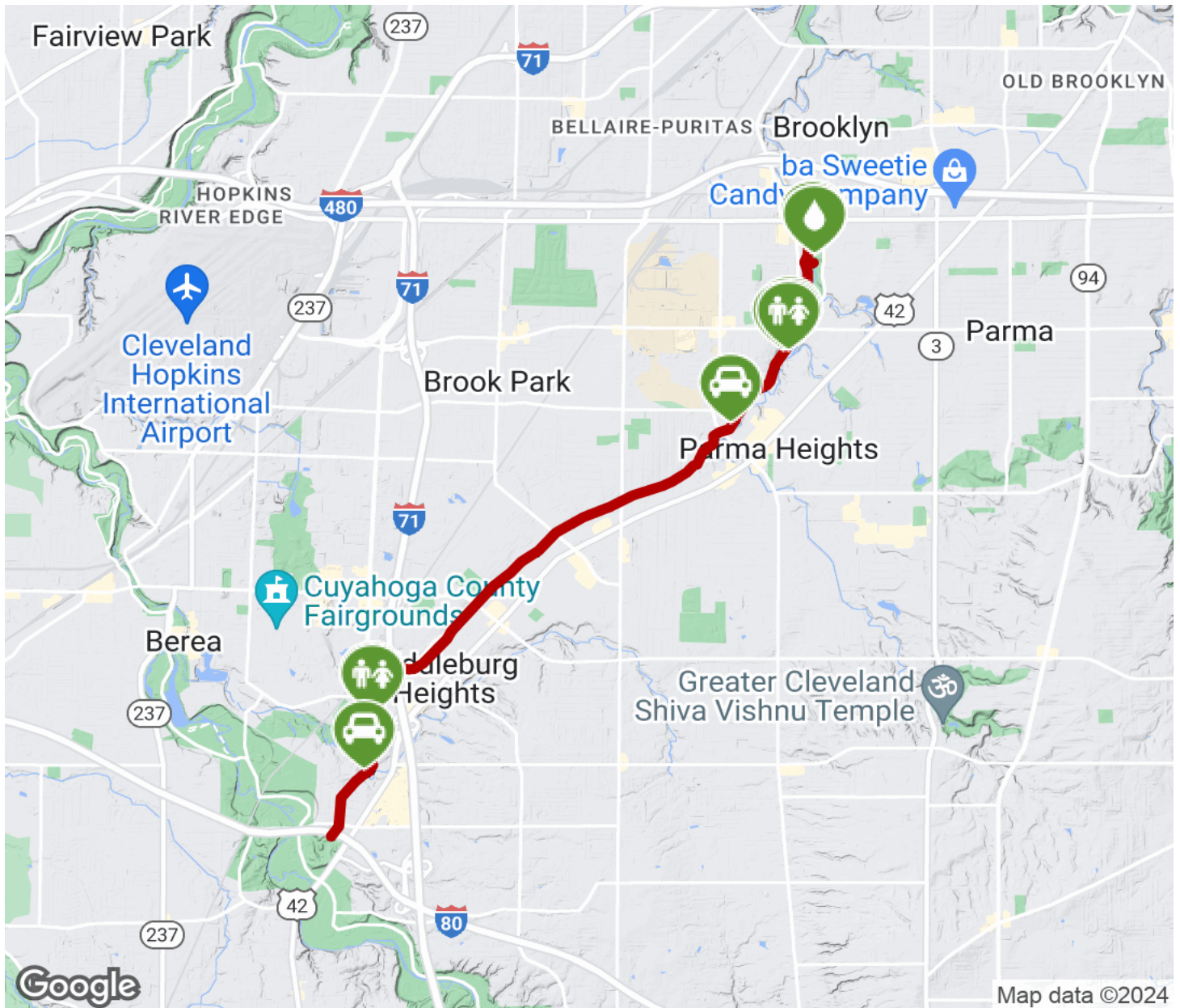
Parking & Trail Access
