The trail on both sides of the waterway was recently rehabilitated with brand new asphalt and widened pathways, as well as stormwater and landscaping improvements, signage, lighting and benches.

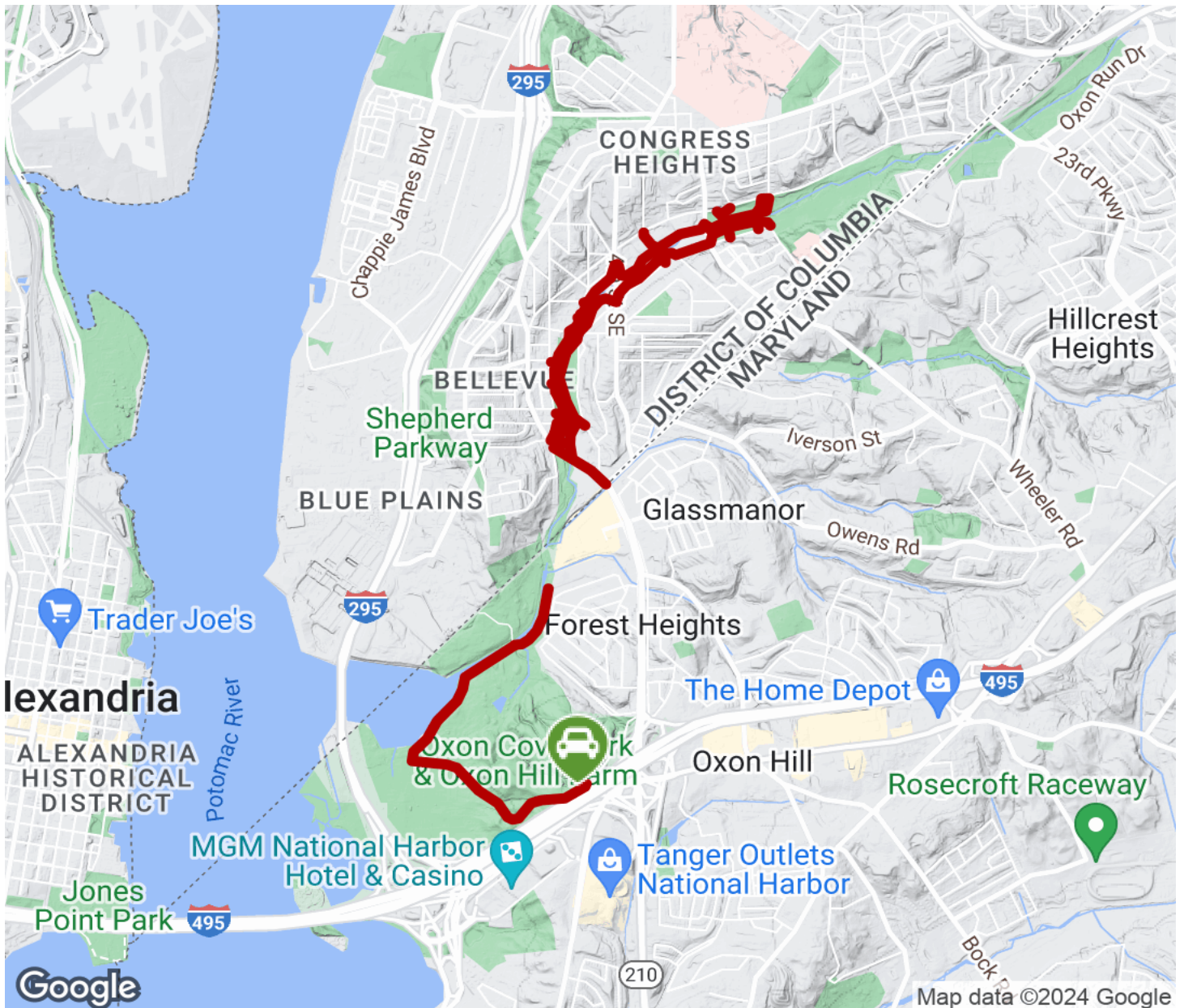
