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Southwest of downtown Pueblo, the Lake Minnequa Trail offers an opportunity to enjoy the outdoors with a flat, gravel pathway that rings a lake and offers views of ponds and wetlands. Parking is available within Lake Minnequa Park and Open Space (1601-1999 Streator Ave.) at the southern end of the trail.



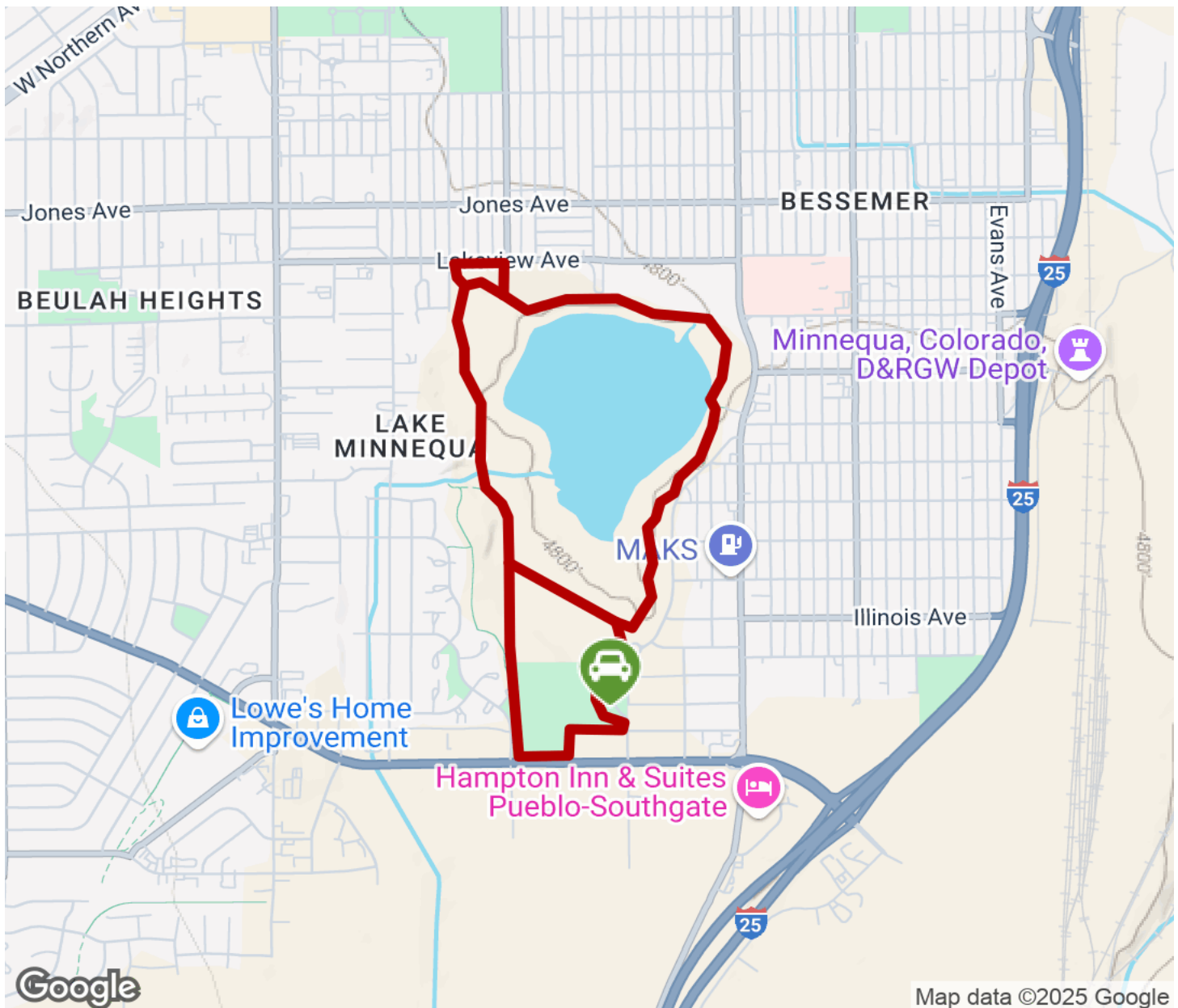
