The Southside Trail is one segment of the [Atlanta BeltLine](#) system, occupying a stretch of former rail corridor to the south of downtown Atlanta. The rail-trail provides a connection between the neighborhoods of Oakland City and Glenwood Park, passing through several other areas along the way, and also serves to connect the ends of the [Westside Trail](#) and the [Eastside Trail](#), creating a continuous pathway across a huge swath of the metropolitan area.


Parking & Trail Access
