It was officially opened in the Fall of 2017 in Little Elm, an extended suburb of Dallas, Texas. The trail is a combination of crushed gravel and boardwalk, drawing walkers, joggers and mountain bikers alike. There are access points to the water for those wishing to fish as well.

Parking & Trail Access

The trail has four trail heads:

- Hula Hut restaurant, southwest of Beard Park
- Beard Park (310 E. Eldorado Parkway)
- Harts Road & El Dorado Parkway
- McCord Park (2050 FM423)

The two parks provide a number of amenities, including parking. Beard Park offers restrooms, a pavilion and a treethemed playground. McCord Park has picnic tables, a playground, passive green space and an 18-hole disc golf course. Hula hut trailhead parking is the lot east of Hula Hut and not the actual restaurant lot.
