Wasson Way runs between Blair Court, just east of Xavier University, and Old Red Bank Rd at the edge of Ault Park in



The trail in the east continues to the wooded grounds of Ault Park. The trail's western end is currently at Old Red Bank Road, a short distance away from the start of the [Fairfax Bike Trail](#) at Woodland Road. A disconnected section of trail runs from the edge of Xavier University west towards Blair Ct.

Connections

When completed, the Wasson Way trail will span 7.6 miles from Victory Parkway (near Xavier University) to the [Little Miami Scenic Trail](#) in Newtown. The latter spans 78 miles from Cincinnati to Springfield and is in the Rail-Trail Hall of Fame.

Wasson Way runs between Blair Court, just east of Xavier University, and Old Red Bank Rd at the edge of Ault Park in Cincinnati.

About the Route

The first section of the developing Wasson Way trail opened in 2018 in the eastern Cincinnati neighborhood of Hyde Park. It measured less than a mile, running past Withrow High School, shops and restaurants as it traveled from Madison Road to Tamarack Avenue, near Dana Avenue and I-71. The second phase extended the trail west to Montgomery Road, and includes a bridge over I-71. Phase 3 extended it east, doubling the length by adding another 1.2 miles stretching to Marburg Avenue.

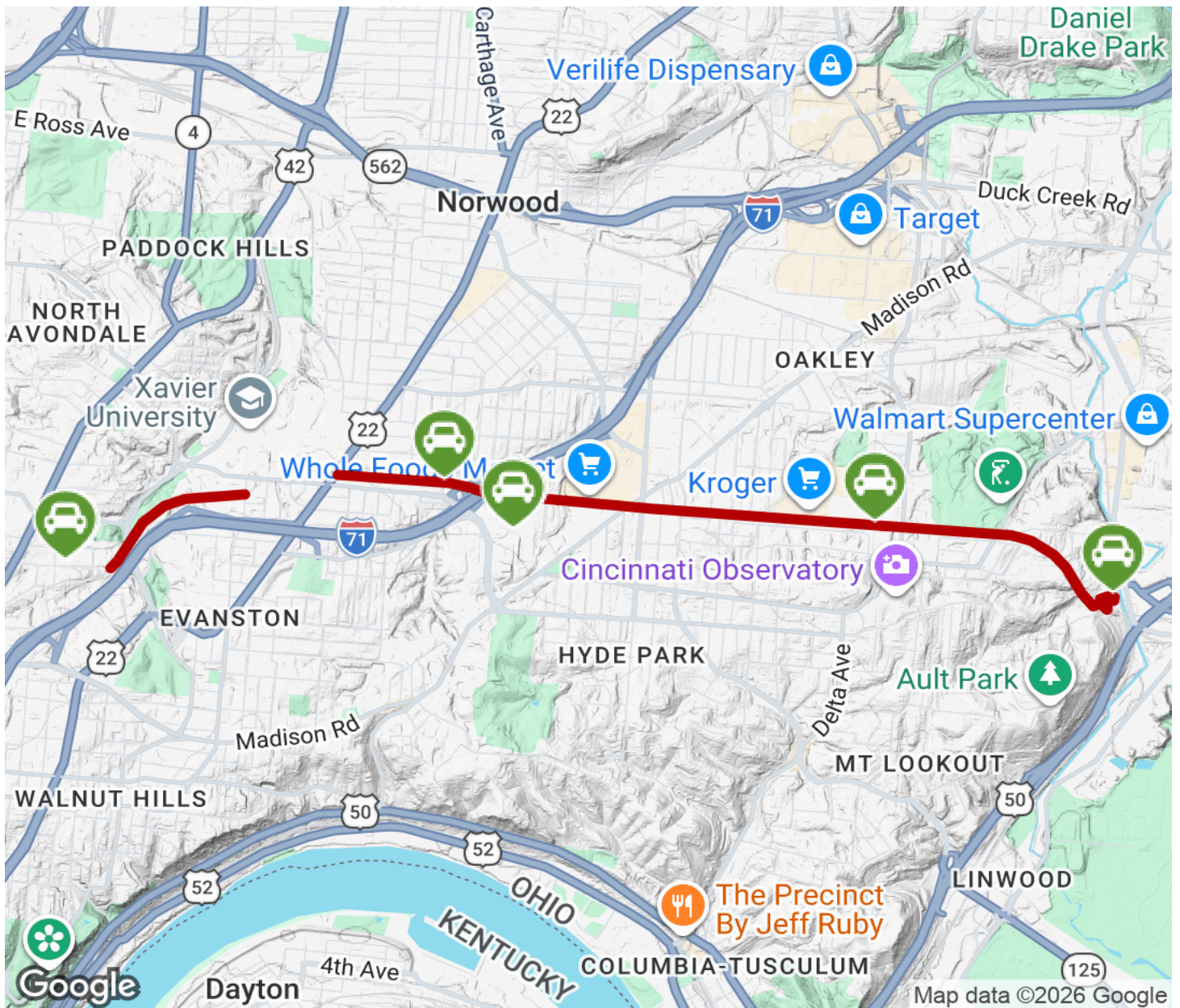
