The Krome Path is a bicycle and pedestrian off-street trail in the southwestern Miami metro area. It's 18.5 miles long, paralleling



The Krome Path is a bicycle and pedestrian off-street trail in the southwestern Miami metro area. It's 18.5 miles long, paralleling Krome Avenue between SW 8th and SW 296th Street. It's a fairly flat, easy ride with intermittent shade depending on the direction of the sun. The trail provides a north-south alternative for non-motorized vehicle users.

The Krome Path is part of the Miami Loop, as well as the Florida Greenways and Trail Network. At its northern end, it meets the Tamiami Trail and the City of Homestead to the south. The project began in 2015 and was completed in January 2021.

You may also be able to park at Dade Corners (gas station/market) at Tamiami Trail (SW 8th Street) & Krome Avenue.



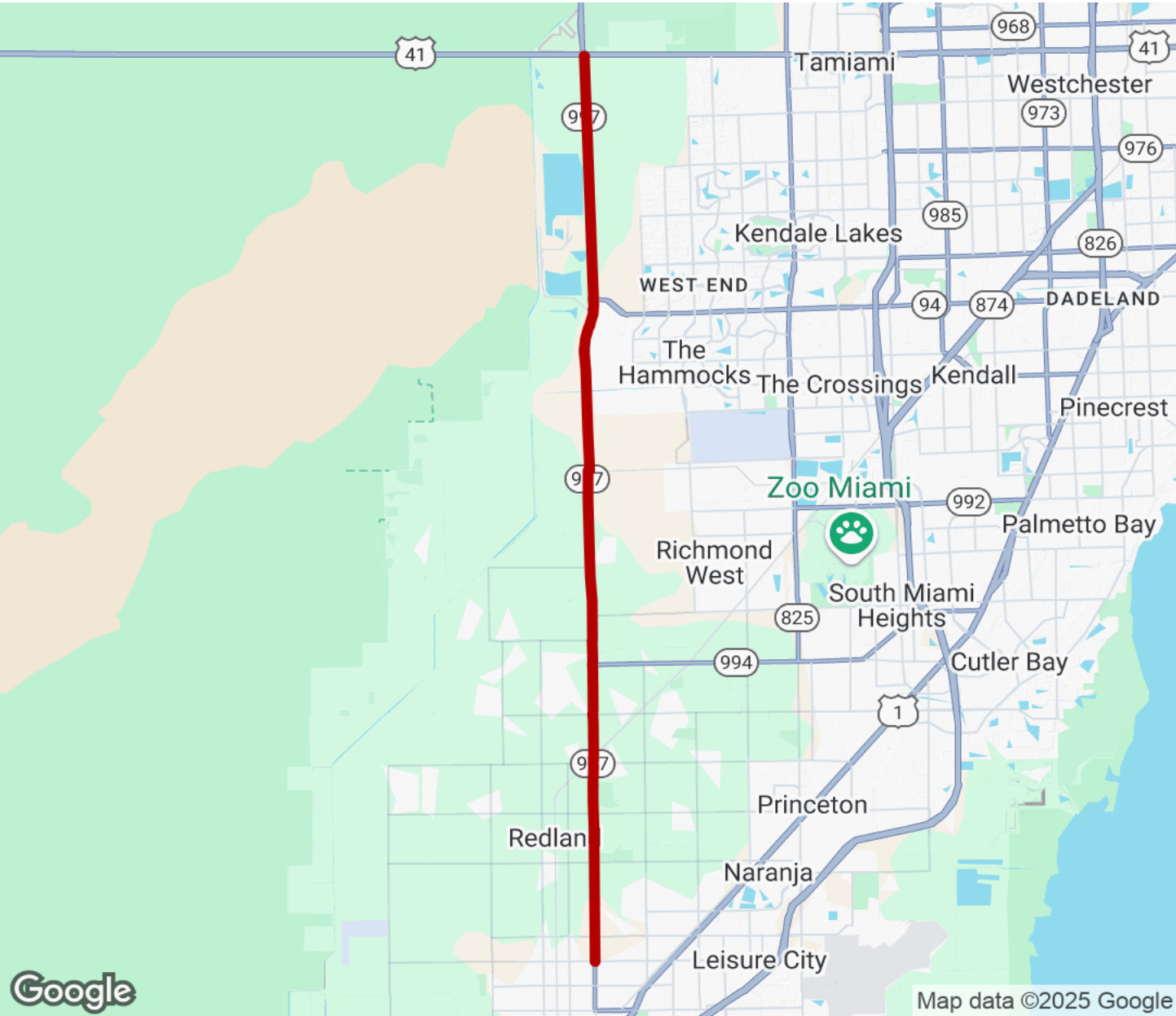
