Laketon Trail
Michigan



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The Laketon Trail offers an important connection between the [Muskegon Lakeshore Trail](#) and the [Musketawa Trail](#) in the City of Muskegon. The paved pathway largely parallels Laketon Avenue, along the former Grand Trunk Railroad, offering a convenient way across town with access to businesses, schools, and residential neighborhoods.

As travelers cross Jefferson Street, they'll also have access to the Jefferson Historic District, which has large Victorian and Queen Ann style homes.

Parking is available at Marsh Field (a baseball facility) on Peck Street and at Reese Playground, which is one block north of the trail off E. Forest Avenue.



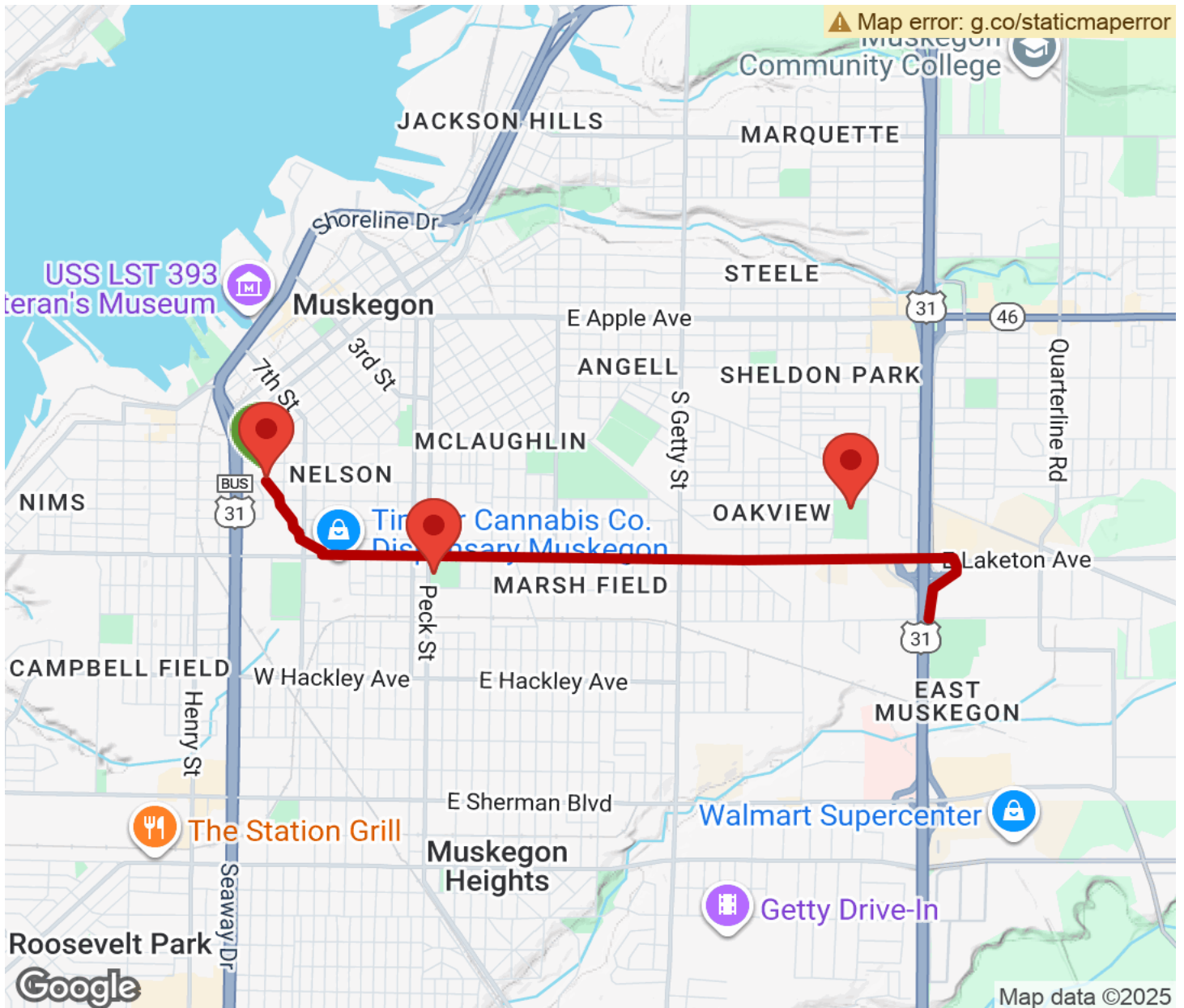
