The Hiawatha Trail provides a convenient way to cross Perry's northeastern neighborhoods and provides a connection to [Raccoon River Valley Trail](#), a scenic 89-mile rail-trail.

The east end of the Hiawatha Trail is anchored by Wiese Park, where you'll find a golf course, playground, sports facilities, and the McCreary Community Building. On its west side, the trail ends adjacent to the Perry Public Library and kitty-corner from Caboose Park.
