The Turner Boulevard Trail offers a north-south route paralleling its namesake roadway through residential neighborhoods on Omaha's west side. Along its two miles, the paved pathway connects three parks: Leavenworth Park, Dewey Park and Turner Park and also meets the Field Club Trail.

On its northern end, you can access Midtown Crossing, a popular shopping and casual dining destination, and, at Cuming Street, there's a connection to the <u>Burt Street Trail</u>, which heads east to the Creighton University campus.

On its southern end, you can connect to the <u>Field Club</u> <u>Trail</u> by heading west down Pacific Street for six blocks.
