## Turner Boulevard Trail

*The Turner Boulevard Trail offers a north-south route paralleling its namesake roadway through residential neighborhoods on*



The Turner Boulevard Trail offers a north-south route paralleling its namesake roadway through residential neighborhoods on Omaha's west side. Along its two miles, the paved pathway connects three parks: Leavenworth Park, Dewey Park and Turner Park and also meets the [Field Club Trail](#).

On its northern end, you can access Midtown Crossing, a popular shopping and casual dining destination, and, at Cuming Street, there's a connection to the [Burt Street Trail](#), which heads east to the Creighton University campus.

On its southern end, you can connect to the [Field Club Trail](#) by heading west down Pacific Street for six blocks.

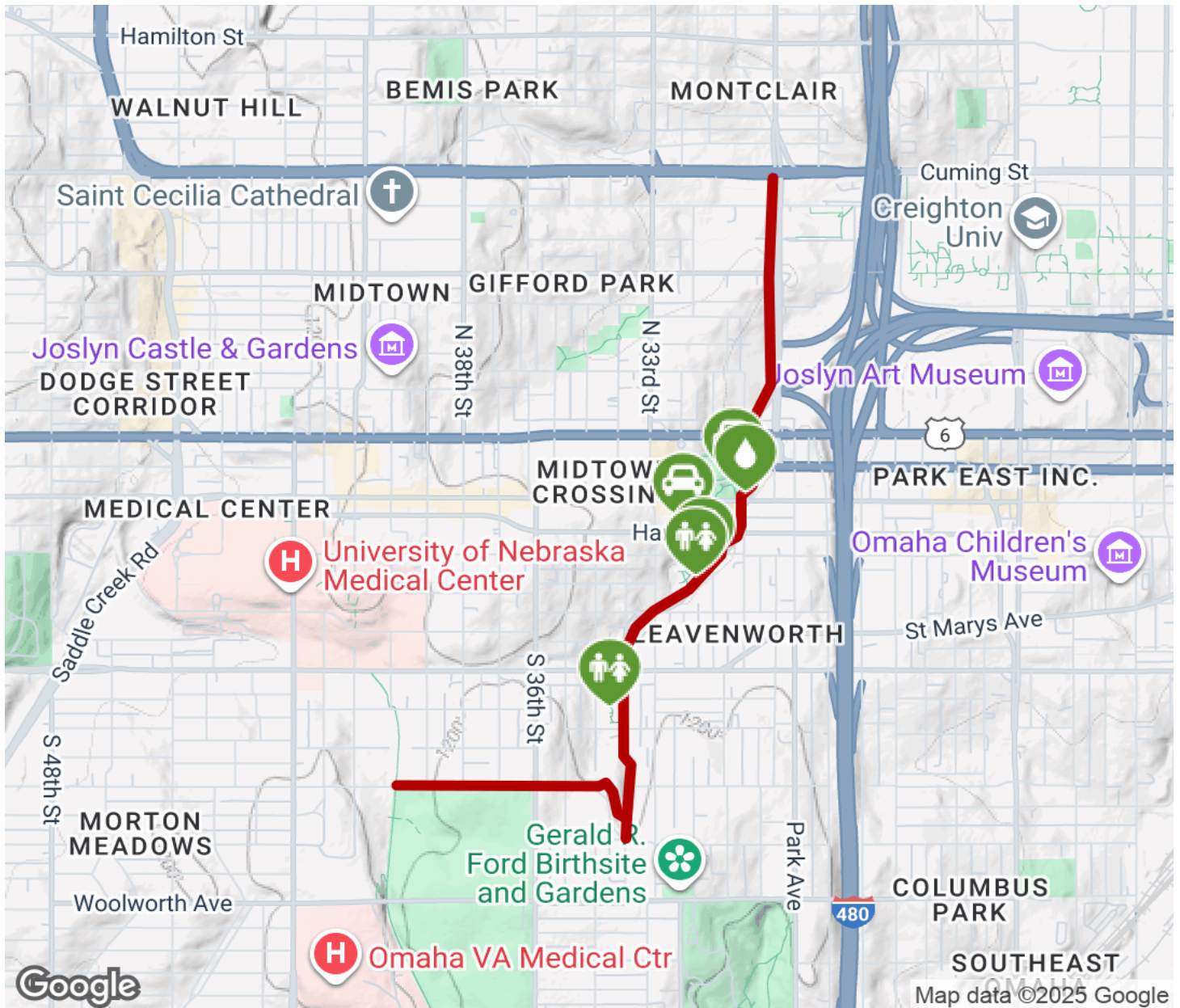
