The North 19th Avenue Trail is an off-road asphalt pathway providing safe walking and biking access to the Bozeman Chamber



The North 19th Avenue Trail is an off-road asphalt pathway providing safe walking and biking access to the Bozeman Chamber of Commerce, as well as restaurants and businesses along a half-mile section of 19th Avenue. Another paved pathway continues along [Oak Street](#), picking up where the 19th Avenue Trail leaves off, but in an east-west direction, rather than in the north-south alignment of 19th Avenue.

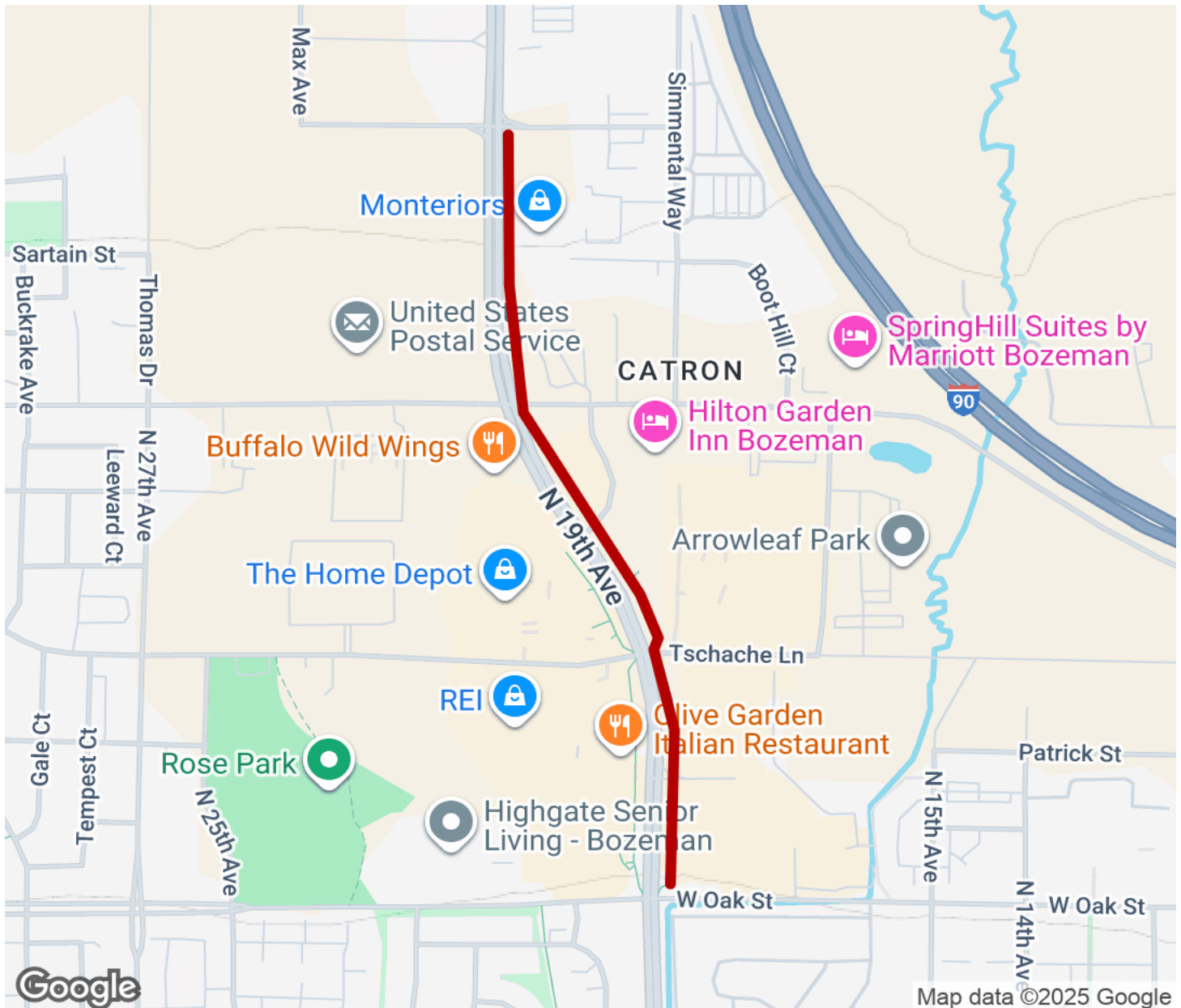
Parking & Trail Access
