Jackrabbit Lane Shared- Use Path

Montana



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The Jackrabbit Lane Shared-Use Path runs through quiet rural communities on the northwestern outskirts of Bozeman. The paved pathway offers a straight north-south route paralleling its namesake roadway. On its east side, the trail provides access to several businesses; to the west, the trail offers views of wide open fields. At its southern end, the path connects to the [Valley Center Trail](#), which travels east-west.

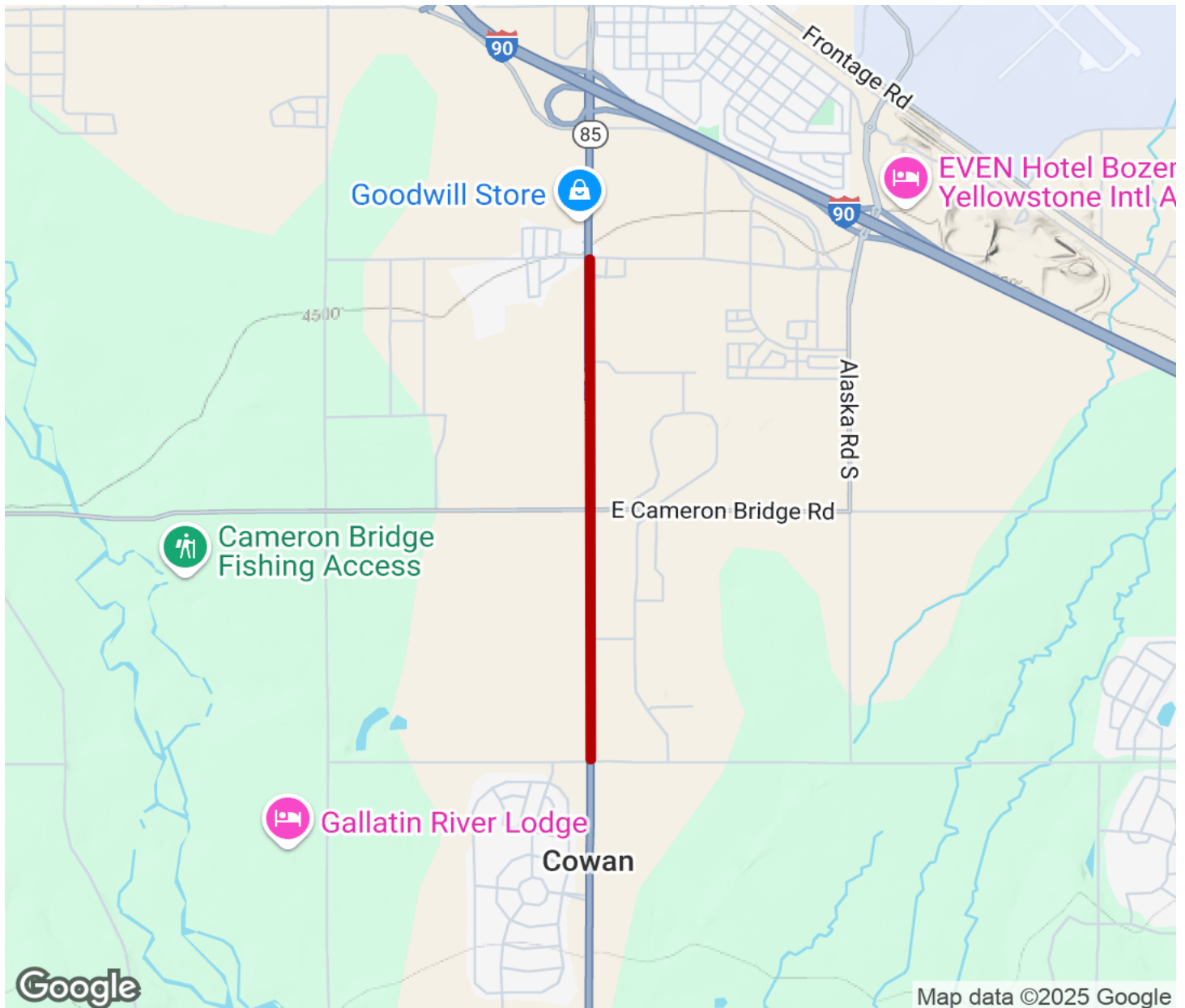
