There are many commercial establishments with parking along Oak Street. Always observe posted rules when you park.



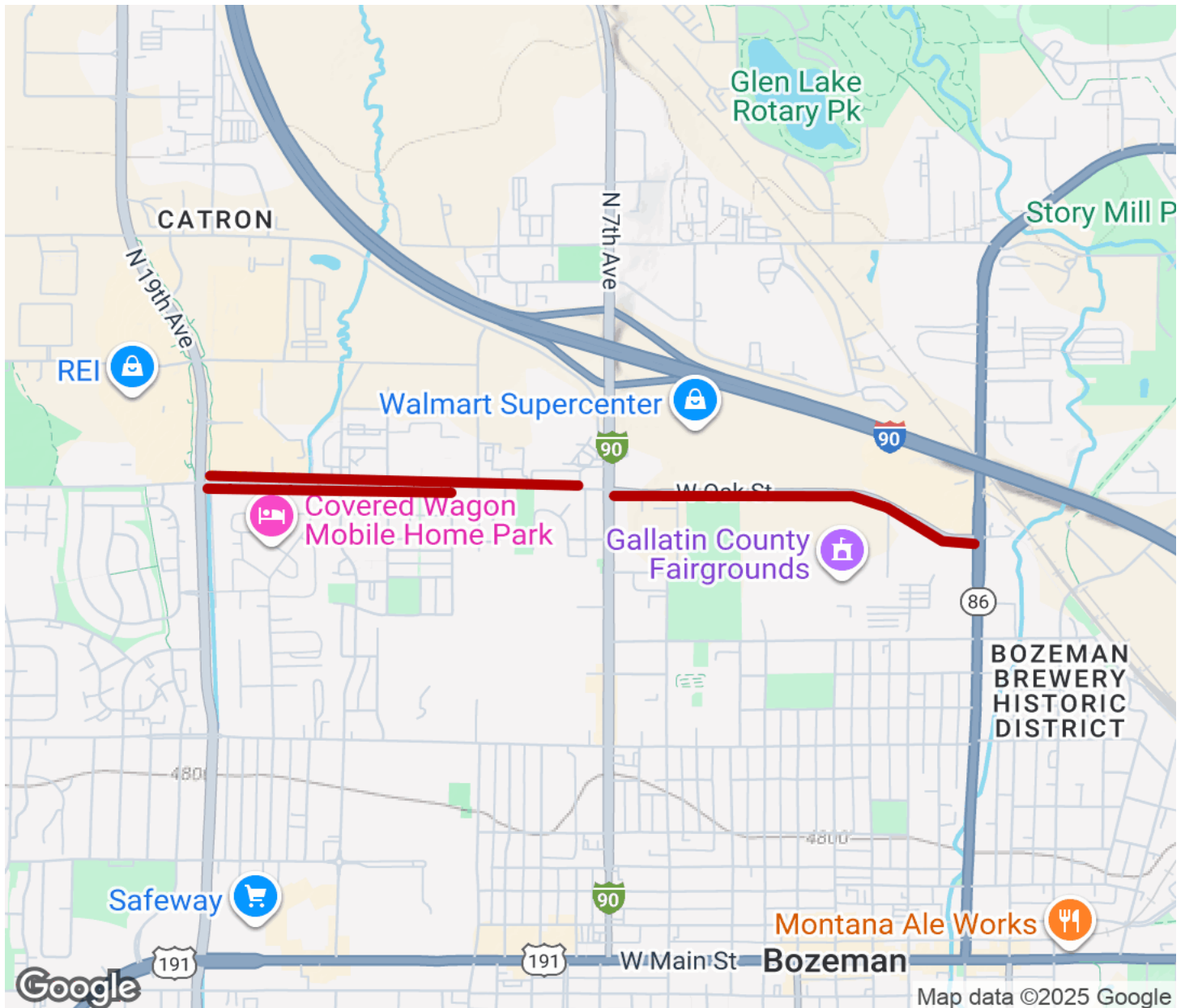
