The A.J. Hoyt Memorial Trail can be found in Frenchtown, a small community about 16 miles northwest of downtown Missoula. The trail parallels the Frenchtown Frontage Road for just over 5 miles and its flat, asphalt surface makes for an easy walk or ride for users of all ages. The trail passes by a mix of homes and ranches, and is close to the Frenchtown Pond State Park, a favorite spot for water-based activities like swimming, kayaking, paddleboarding and snorkeling.

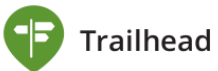
Parking & Trail Access
