

West Cobb Trail Georgia



The West Cobb Trail is a 2-way dedicated pathway within the right-of-way of the Ernest Barrett Parkway (State Route 5 Connector).



The West Cobb Trail is a 2-way dedicated pathway within the right-of-way of the Ernest Barrett Parkway (State Route 5 Connector). The trail follows the arterial through a residential part of the northwestern Atlanta metro area. West of the intersection with Old Highway 41 you can also find shopping and restaurants. Old US 41 is also where the trail meets the Noonday Creek Trail, which if you follow southeast for about 1.3 miles, will take you to the Kennesaw Mountain National Battlefield Park.


