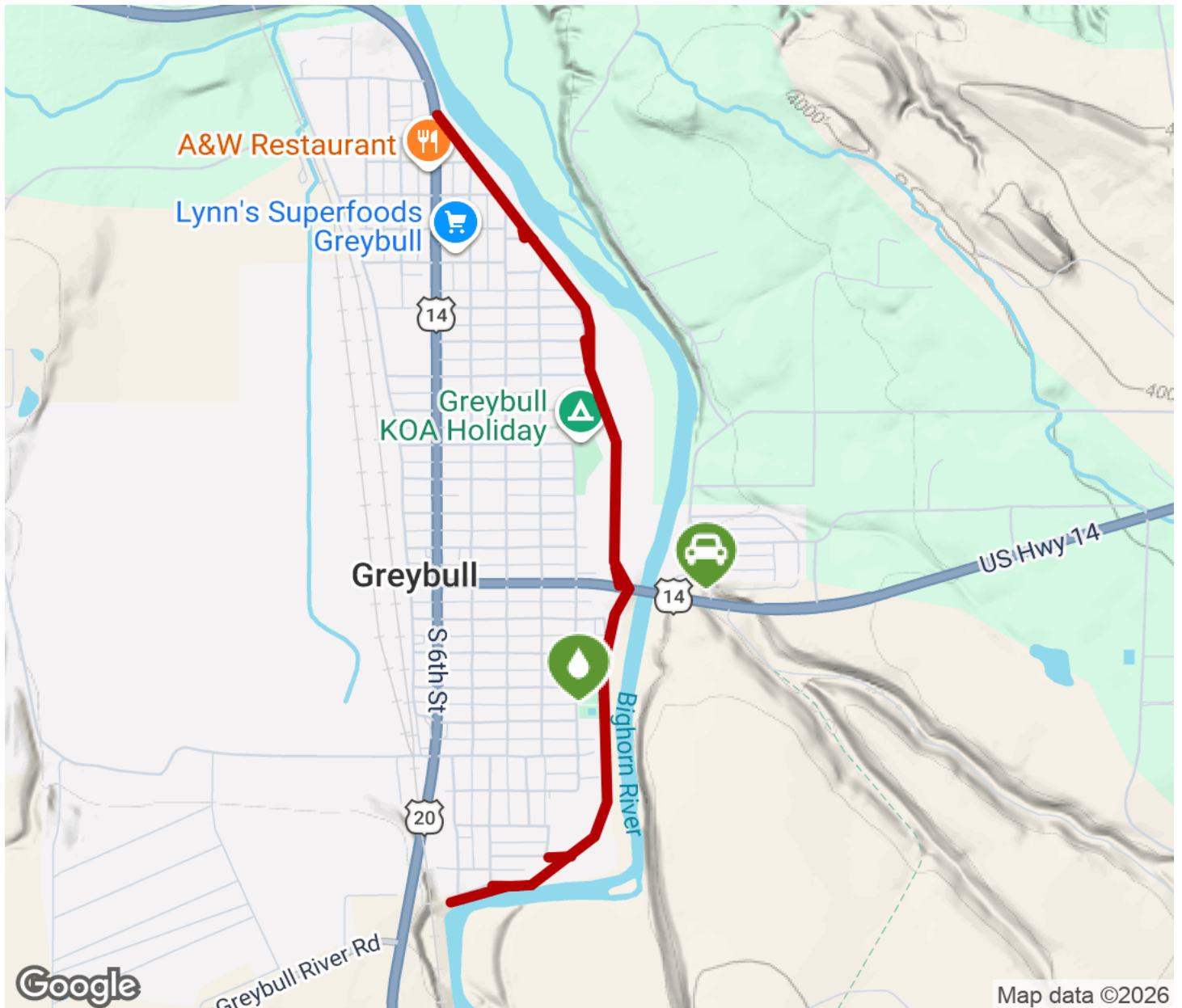
Parking & Trail Access

The trail passes close to the Greybull City Park. The park hosts a variety of amenities including restrooms, tree-shaded picnic tables, walking paths, skate ramps and a children's play area. From the park's northern end, you can access the trail via 2nd Avenue; from its southern end, past the Senior Center, you can enter the trail via 5th Avenue S.
