North 1st Street Trail

The North 1st Street Trail parallels its namesake road through Lincoln's northwestern neighborhoods between Cornhusker



The North 1st Street Trail parallels its namesake road through Lincoln's northwestern neighborhoods between Cornhusker Highway and Superior Street. Near its southern end, the trail offers access to West Lincoln Park, which has a playground and basketball court. The concrete pathway also connects to two other trails at either end: at its northern terminus, it links up with the [Superior Street Trail](#) and, at its southern end, it's anchored by the [Oak Lake Connector Trail](#).


Parking & Trail Access
