The Limestone Greenway follows the former Illinois Central Railroad for 1.7 miles south of Bloomington. It's a smooth, asphalt trail that's easy enough for people of all ages to enjoy. The pathway offers a rural, wooded experience, taking users under a lush tree canopy. At its northern trailhead on W. Church Lane, the Limestone Greenway connects to two other rail-trails for a longer journey: the <u>Clear Creek Trail</u> and the <u>Bloomington Rail</u> <u>Trail</u> (which in turn connects with the <u>B-Line Trail</u>).
