In addition, in Carmel there is a small bike-ped bridge over Williams Creek.

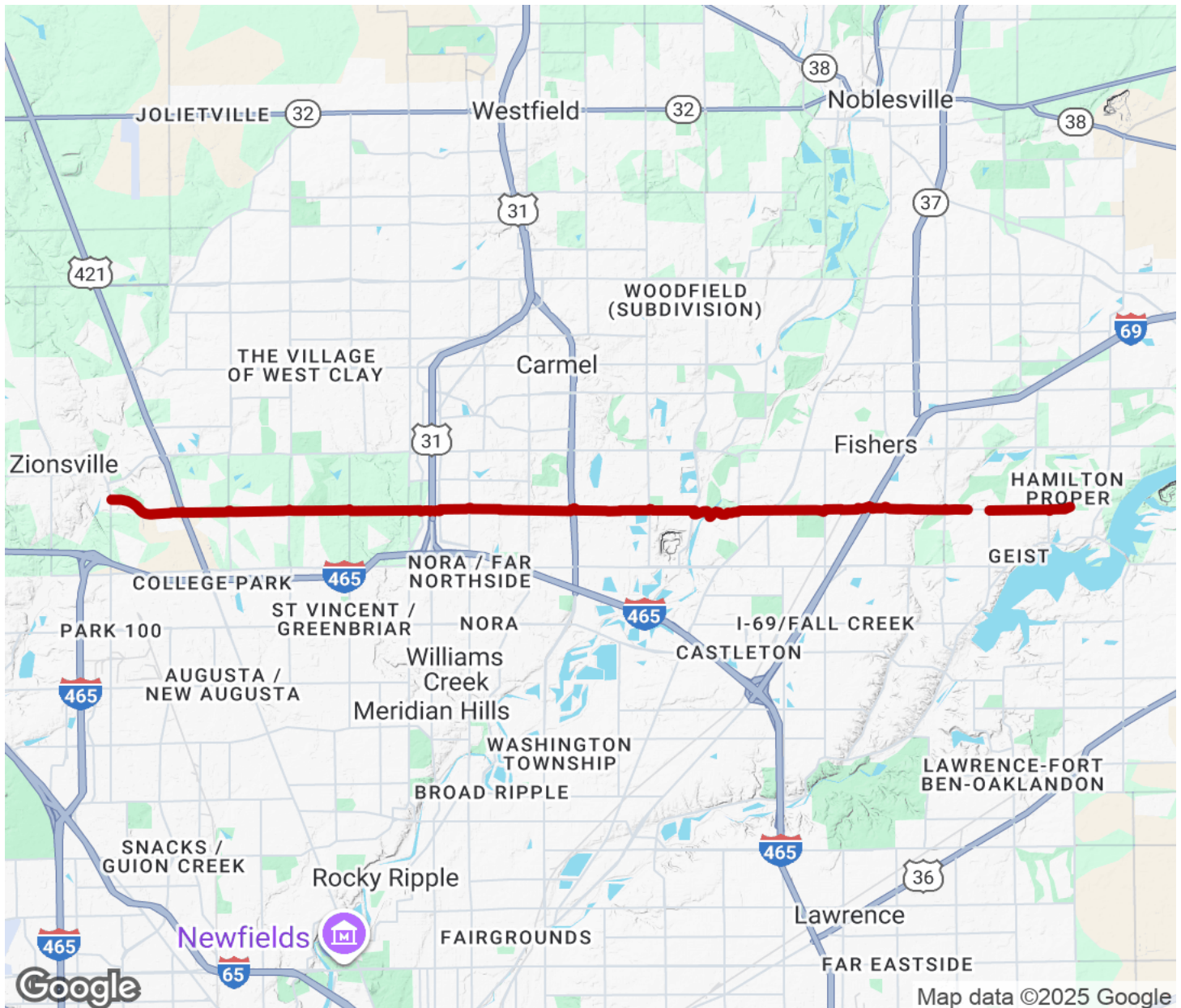
