The 106 is a smooth asphalt connector linking the communities of Zionsville and Carmel. The trail connects Carmel by crossing US 31 and then continuing alongside the roadway to Zionsville Road, passing by neighborhoods, churches and businesses. In addition, in Carmel there is a small bike-ped bridge over Williams Creek.


