The Concord Road Trail is a hard-surface hike and bike path located alongside the road of the same name in Smyrna, Georgia.



The Concord Road Trail is a hard-surface hike and bike path located alongside the road of the same name in Smyrna, Georgia. The trail begins at the intersection of Concord and Atlanta Roads, where it also meets the Smyrna-Atlanta Road Trail. The trail setting switches between busy commercial centers and quiet neighborhoods of single-family homes. South of the East-West Connector, the trail enters Heritage Park where it meets the famous 62-mile [Silver Comet Trail](#).

Expect plenty of road crossings and some rolling terrain along the three-mile route - and don't hold your breath for much natural scenery - but the trail makes for a nice link between the heart of Smyrna and the extremely popular Silver Comet Trail.

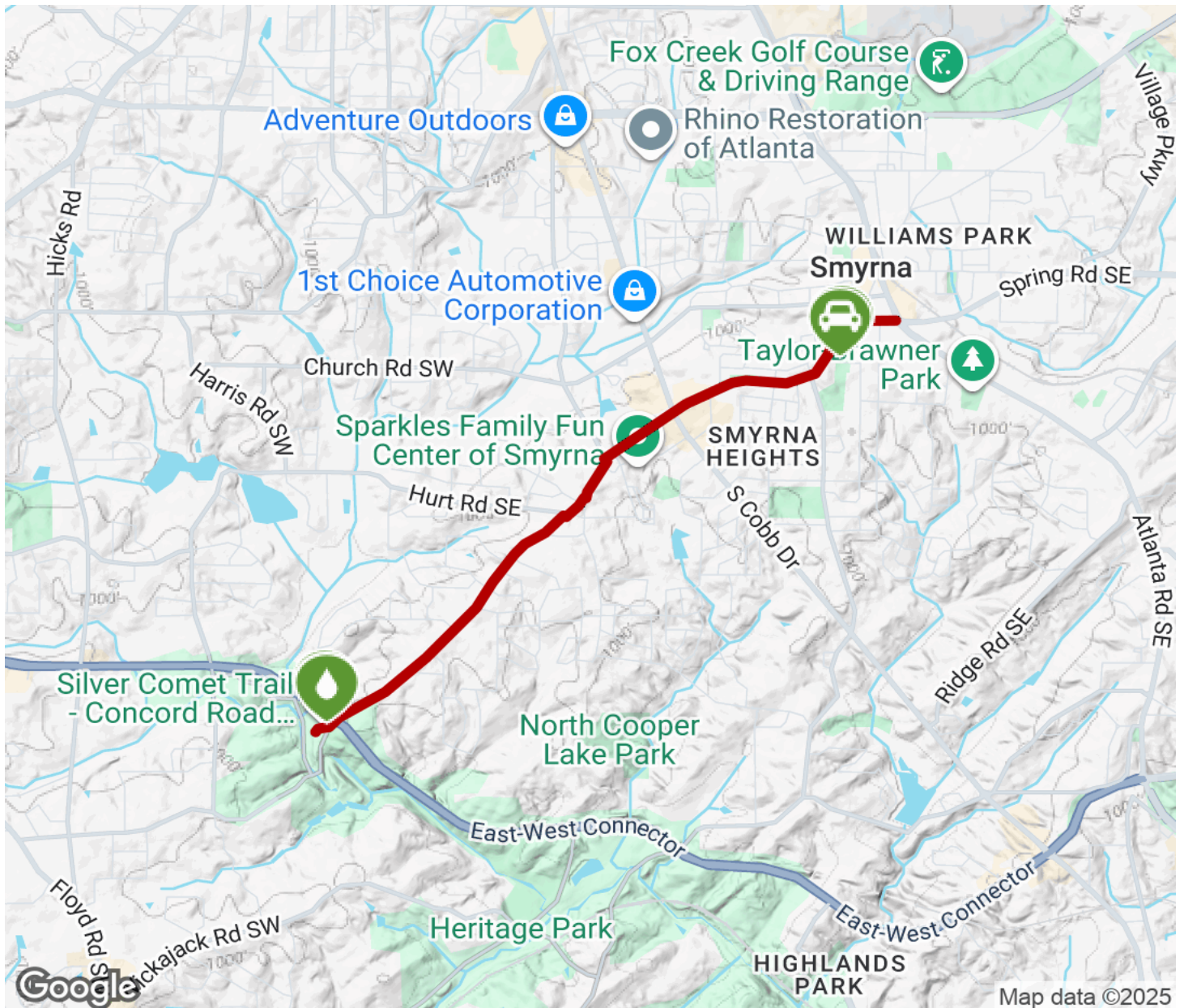
Park at the Silver Comet Trail / Concord Road Trailhead just south of where Concord Road passes the East-West Connector.
