On the east end of the trail, parking is available off Turkey Lane, just south of Highway 16.



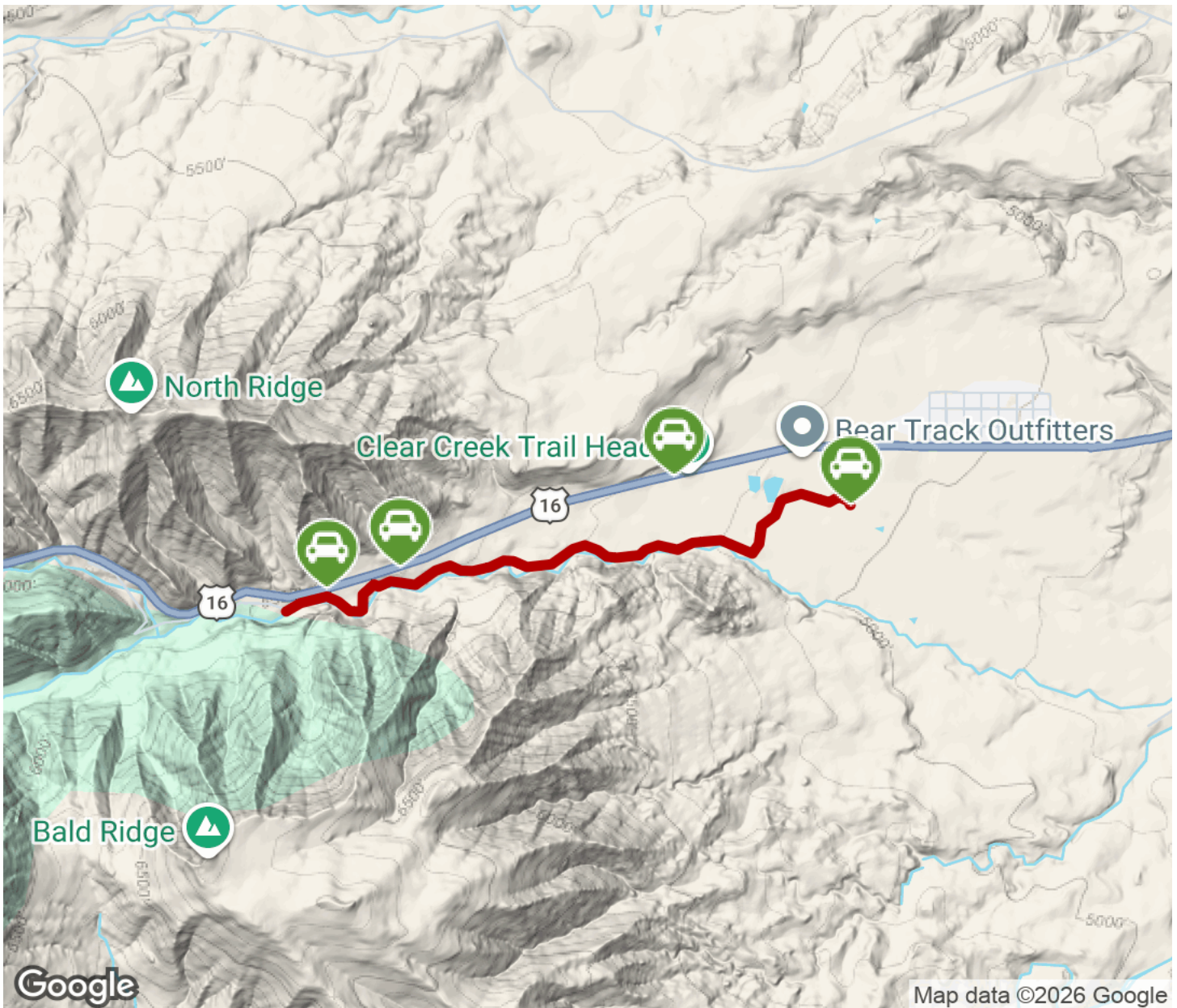
