The north-south trail extends from Cypress Parkway to Orange Blossom Trail (US Highway 17/ 92) through a setting that alternates between fast food and small retail to suburban residential. The trail provides an alternative to driving for local residents who are looking to run quick errands or grab a bite to eat.


