Westminster, Colorado, has over 145 miles of dedicated non-motorized trails, from major bike thoroughfares to the smaller local routes like this one, which knit them all together.

The trail on Lowell Boulevard intersects with the <u>Little</u> <u>Dry Creek Trail</u> at its southern end. At its northern terminus, it meets the Turnpike Trail, another link which in turn connects to the <u>US 36 Bikeway</u>.

There's also destinations to connect to along the trail itself, which provides access to Westminster Station Park, Hidden Lake High School, Torri Square Park, churches and a post office.
