True to its name the South Link Greenway connects three of Cheyenne's prominent shared use pathways. It runs north-south,



True to its name the South Link Greenway connects three of Cheyenne's prominent shared use pathways. It runs north-south, from the East Cheyenne Greenway, (which stretches west for almost 4 miles ending at Holliday Park, where there is a display of a giant mid-century steam engine) down Logan Avenue, 5th Street and Morrie Avenue, past a mix of residential and industrial including the Frontier Refinery. On Morrie Avenue, it ducks under IO80/ Lincoln Highway. At E. 1St Street you can peel away to join the Crow Creek Greenway. Continuing south, Morrie turns to Avenue C. The trail connects to the Allison Creek Greenway at its southern end. That greenway connects to Laramie Community College in the east.
