South Link Greenway

Wyoming

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True to its name the South Link Greenway connects three of Cheyenne's prominent shared use pathways. It runs north-south, from the [East Cheyenne Greenway](#), (which stretches west for almost 4 miles ending at Holliday Park, where there is a display of a giant mid-century steam engine) down Logan Avenue, 5th Street and Morrie Avenue, past a mix of residential and industrial including the Frontier Refinery. On Morrie Avenue, it ducks under I080/ Lincoln Highway. At E. 1st Street you can peel away to join the [Crow Creek Greenway](#). Continuing south, Morrie turns to Avenue C. The trail connects to the [Allison Creek Greenway](#) at its southern end. That greenway connects to Laramie Community College in the east.

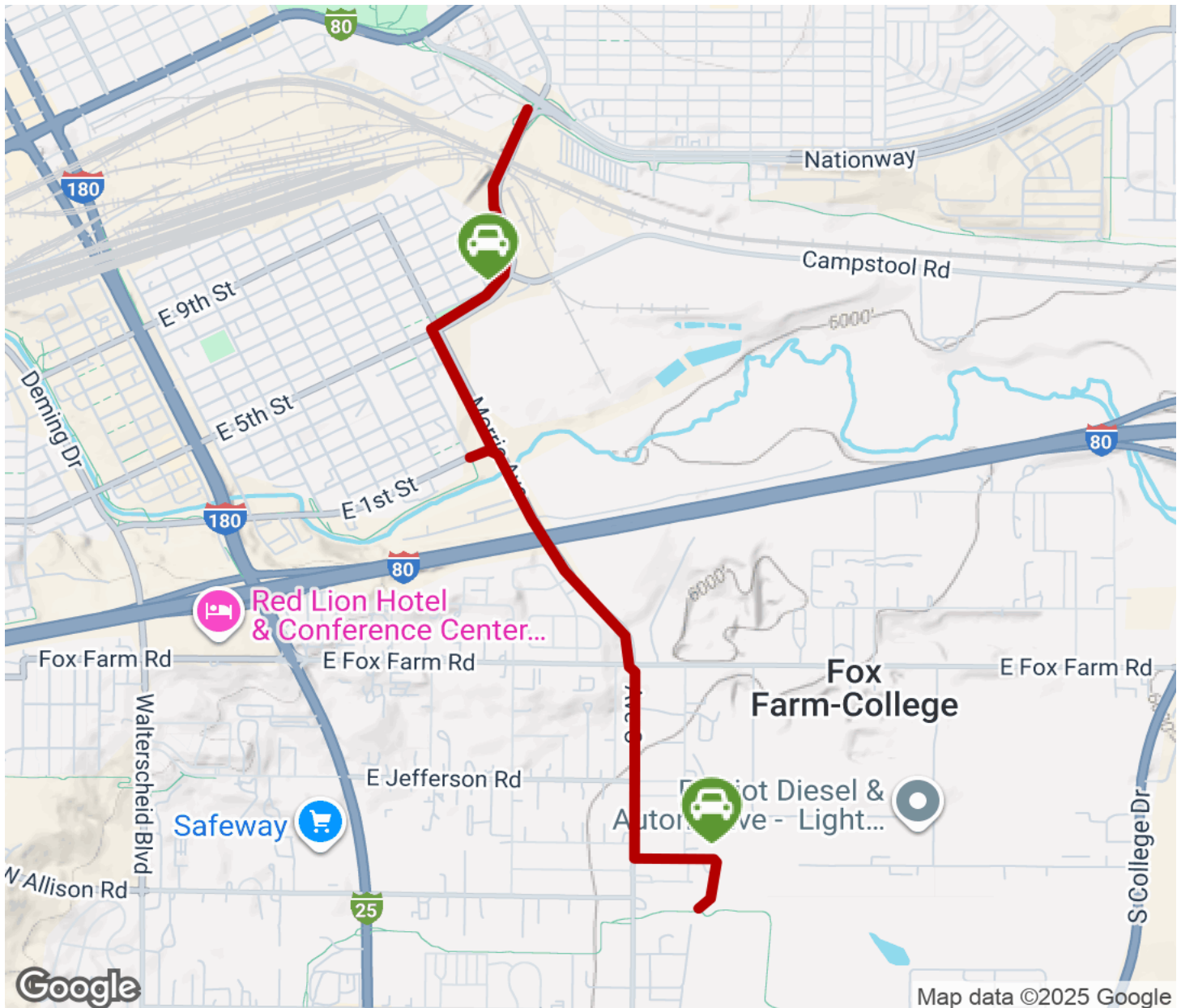
Parking & Trail Access
